#### (1) Overview of operating results for the period

The Group's results for the first six months of the current fiscal year were as follows.

Net sales of completed construction contracts and profits exceeded the results of the same period of the previous year. In addition, actual results exceeded all of the semi-annual consolidated results forecasts announced on April 25, 2025.

Non-consolidated financial results were as follows.

Net sales of completed construction contracts and profits exceeded the results of the same period of the previous year. In addition, actual results exceeded all of the semi-annual non-consolidated results forecasts announced on April 25, 2025.

#### Non-consolidated net sales of completed construction contracts

Net sales of completed construction contracts increased by \\pm 11,532 million to \\\pm 267,440 million (up 4.5% year on year).

Net sales of completed construction contracts by customers, The Kansai Electric Power Company, Incorporated (including Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc.) increased by \(\frac{\pma}{3}\),012 million to \(\frac{\pma}{4}\)3,276 million (up 7.5% year on year), The Kansai Electric Power Group increased by \(\frac{\pma}{2}\),726 million to \(\frac{\pma}{1}\)10,387 million (up 35.6% year on year), and Others increased by \(\frac{\pma}{5}\),793 million to \(\frac{\pma}{2}\)13,775 million (up 2.8% year on year).

Net sales of completed construction contracts by construction sector, Power Distribution Lining increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2,684}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3,594}\) million (up 7.5% year on year), Electrical increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2,082}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{2,012}\) million (up 1.2% year on year), Information & Communications Network increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2,805}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{20,126}\) million (up 16.2% year on year), Environmental Management Facilities increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3,358}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{25,106}\) million (up 15.4% year on year), and Electric Power & Others increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{602}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{10,699}\) million (up 6.0% year on year). The main factors contributing to the increase in Power Distribution Lining were an increase in the volume of construction by Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc., while the main factors behind the increases in factories and logistics facilities, etc., despite decreases in office buildings, commercial and entertainment facilities, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Environmental Management Facilities were increases in office buildings and factories, etc., despite decreases in commercial and entertainment facilities, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Electric Power & Others were increases in work on power plants and substations, etc.

#### Non-consolidated construction orders

Construction orders increased by ¥81,988 million to ¥460,889 million (up 21.6% year on year).

Construction orders by customers, The Kansai Electric Power Company, Incorporated (including Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc.) increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{3},434\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4}6,404\) million (up 8.0% year on year), The Kansai Electric Power Group increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1},927\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1}0,166\) million (up 23.4% year on year), and Others increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{7}}{7}6,626\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4}04,317\) million (up 23.4% year on year).

Construction orders by construction sector, Power Distribution Lining increased by ¥1,570 million to ¥41,376 million (up 3.9% year on year), Electrical increased by ¥55,536 million to ¥319,466 million

(up 21.0% year on year), Information & Communications Network increased by ¥6,186 million to ¥30,511 million (up 25.4% year on year), Environmental Management Facilities increased by ¥1,842 million to ¥34,014 million (up 5.7% year on year), and Electric Power & Others increased by ¥16,851 million to ¥35,520 million (up 90.3% year on year). The main factors contributing to the increase in Power Distribution Lining were increases in the volume of construction by Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc., while the main factors behind the increase in Electrical were increases in office buildings, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Information & Communications Network were increases in local area network, etc., while the main factors behind the increase in Environmental Management Facilities were increases in logistics facilities, etc., despite decreases in factories, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Electric Power & Others were increases in work on power plants and substations, etc.

#### (2) Overview of financial position for the period

#### Assets

Current assets decreased by \$63,444 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$440,211 million (down 12.6% from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to a decrease in notes receivable, accounts receivable from completed construction contracts and other resulting from the collection of construction costs. Cash on hand (cash and cash equivalents) decreased by \$19,440 million to \$165,222 million.

Non-current assets increased by ¥69,362 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥3,874 million (up 21.8% from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to increases in construction in progress and goodwill.

As a result, total assets increased by \$5,918 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$827,612 million (up 0.7% from the end of the previous fiscal year).

#### Liabilities

Current liabilities decreased by \$20,528 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$181,929 million (down 10.1% from the end of the previous fiscal year). The main factors behind the decrease were decreases in notes payable, accounts payable for construction contracts and other due to progress made in paying trade payables on material costs, etc. and a decrease in income taxes payable due to payment of income taxes, etc.

Non-current liabilities increased by \$8,536 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$28,034 million (up 43.8% from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to increases in deferred tax liabilities and asset retirement obligations.

As a result, total liabilities decreased by \$11,991 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$209,963 million (down 5.4% from the end of the previous fiscal year).

#### Net assets

Shareholders' equity increased by \(\pm\)11,058 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \(\pm\)539,976 million (up 2.1% from the end of the previous fiscal year), due to the recording of profit attributable to owners of parent, dividends of surplus and purchase of treasury shares. Accumulated other comprehensive income increased by \(\pm\)6,974 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \(\pm\)77,100 million (up 9.9% from the end of the previous fiscal year), mainly due to an increase in valuation difference on available-for-sale securities.

Non-controlling interests were ¥571 million (down 17.7% from the end of the previous fiscal year).

As a result, net assets increased by \(\pm\)17,910 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \(\pm\)617,648 million (up 3.0% from the end of the previous fiscal year). Equity-to-asset ratio was 74.6%, an increase of 1.7 percentage points from the end of the previous fiscal year.

#### (3) Explanation of consolidated earnings forecast and other forward-looking statements

In light of the financial results for the six months ended September 30, 2025, in which both the consolidated and non-consolidated results exceeded the forecast figures announced on April 25, 2025, and considering the favorable market conditions and the status of the contract backlog for the second half of the fiscal year, the Company has revised the forecasts for net sales and each profit category.
