The earnings forecast and other forward-looking statements herein are based on the information currently available and certain assumptions deemed reasonable by the Company, and thus actual results may differ significantly from these forecasts due to a wide range of factors.

(Regarding dividends and performance forecast after the share split)

At a Board of Directors meeting held on August 7, 2025, the Company resolved to conduct a share split at a ratio of 3 shares for each common share, effective October 1, 2025. The dividend forecast and the consolidated results forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 without considering the share split would be as follows:

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1. Overview of Operating Results, etc.

(1) Overview of Operating Results for the Three Months Ended June 30, 2025

During the three months ended June 30, 2025, the Japanese economy continued to recover moderately owing to an improved employment and income environment and the effect of various government policies, as well as an expansion in inbound tourism demand and other factors. However, the outlook continues to be uncertain given factors such as the continued rise in prices and concerns regarding the impact of U.S. trade policy on the global economy.

Under these circumstances, for the three months ended June 30, 2025, the TDK Group recorded orders received of 33,232 million yen (a decrease of 30.3% YoY) and net sales of 29,572 million yen (a decrease of 1.7% YoY) including 1,405 million yen (an increase of 74.1%) for overseas works.

Regarding profits, operating profit amounted to 1,567 million yen (a decrease of 36.9% YoY), ordinary profit amounted to 1,655 million yen (a decrease of 50.0% YoY), and profit attributable to owners of parent amounted to 1,115 million yen (a decrease of 50.1% YoY).

Performance results by business segment are as follows.

(Construction Segment)

Orders received amounted to 14,894 million yen (a decrease of 49.2% YoY, composition ratio: 44.8%). Works for thermal power plants for business use decreased, resulting in a decrease for the overall segment.

Net sales amounted to 9,126 million yen (a decrease of 5.5% YoY, composition ratio: 30.9%). Despite an increase in works for thermal power plants for private use, works for thermal power plants for business use decreased, resulting in a decrease for the overall segment. Segment profit amounted to 310 million yen (a decrease of 48.9% YoY).

(Maintenance and Renovation Segment)

Orders received amounted to 18,337 million yen (a decrease of 0.0% YoY, composition ratio: 55.2%). Despite an increase in works for thermal power plants for private use, works for thermal power plants for business use and iron and steel-related plants decreased, resulting in a decrease for the overall segment.

Net sales amounted to 20,445 million yen (an increase of 0.1% YoY, composition ratio: 69.1%). Despite a decrease in works for thermal power plants for business use, works for thermal power plants for private use and iron and steel-related plants increased, resulting in an increase for the overall segment. Segment profit amounted to 2,613 million yen (a decrease of 17.0% YoY).

The main factor contributing to the decrease in profits was the slump in works for nuclear power plants.

(2) Overview of Financial Position for the Three Months Ended June 30, 2025

(a) Assets

Current assets amounted to 103,942 million yen, down 4,666 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to a decrease of 8,718 million yen in notes receivable, accounts receivable from completed construction contracts, and contract assets, despite an increase of 2,383 million yen in costs on construction contracts in progress and 1,432 million yen in other current assets.

Non-current assets amounted to 48,109 million yen, up 1,642 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 1,683 million yen in investment securities.

(b) Liabilities

Current liabilities amounted to 20,270 million yen, down 3,221 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to decreases of 2,649 million yen in income taxes payable and 802 million yen in other current liabilities.

Non-current liabilities amounted to 17,464 million yen, up 937 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 962 million yen in deferred tax liabilities.

(c) Net assets

Net assets amounted to 114,317 million yen, down 740 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to a decrease of 2,547 million yen in retained earnings, despite an increase of 1,117 million yen in valuation difference on available-for-sale securities.

(3) Explanation of Consolidated Financial Results Forecast and Other Forward-looking Information

There is no change to the consolidated financial results forecast for the full year from the forecast in the "Consolidated Financial Statements for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2025" published on May 14, 2025.

The company hereby announces that it has resolved, at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on August 7, 2025, to conduct a stock split, partially amend the Articles of Incorporation in connection with the stock split, and revise the dividend forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026.
