Timee has entered into a basic agreement with NTT DOCOMO and SBI Sumishin Net Bank regarding a business alliance in the financial field

— Commencing full-scale considerations toward developing a financial platform, including banking services —

Timee, Inc. (Headquarters: Minato-ku, Tokyo; President: Ryo Ogawa; hereinafter "Timee"), provider of the on-demand job platform "Timee," had previously executed a basic agreement with NTT DOCOMO, INC. (Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President and Chief Executive Officer: Yoshiaki Maeda; hereinafter "NTT DOCOMO") and SBI Sumishin Net Bank, Ltd. (Headquarters: Minato-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Noriaki Maruyama; hereinafter "SBI Sumishin Net Bank") to pursue a collaboration primarily focusing on the financial field (hereinafter the "Collaboration"). Moving forward, we will begin full-scale considerations to develop a financial platform that includes banking services.

■ Background

In line with our corporate mission of "Building infrastructure for expanding life's possibilities through work," we have been providing the on-demand job platform "Timee." Since its launch in 2018, we have strived to realize a society where individuals can access a working style that suits them, free from the constraints of time and location. Today, the service is used by over 14.20 million workers (as of the end of April 2026).

Meanwhile, by providing services such as fast payments in our spot work business, we have come to recognize workers' acute short-term financial needs. At the same time, we have frequently encountered various challenges they face, including financial anxieties about the future and the inability to take the next step to upskill due to financial constraints, despite a strong desire to do so. We believe there is still significant room for us to contribute not only to expanding work opportunities themselves, but also to enhancing the everyday convenience and future choices available to these workers. We consider it part of our role to continually empower workers to make choices that are true to themselves. Based on this perspective, we have decided to expand our scope beyond the existing spot work business and begin considering the provision of a financial platform, including banking services, as a new business domain.

■ Overview

The three companies—Timee, NTT DOCOMO, and SBI Sumishin Net Bank—had previously executed a basic agreement regarding a business alliance in the financial field. We will now commence full-scale considerations to deliver banking services for workers using Timee and others, leveraging the BaaS solution provided by SBI Sumishin Net Bank. Furthermore, Timee will establish a subsidiary to commercialize financial solutions and other services using the on-demand job platform "Timee." With this new subsidiary serving as the operating entity, we will consider developing and providing financial services. Through this collaboration, we aim to realize a society where everyone can equally expand the possibilities of their lives.
