Contract Signed for the "Nagasaki City and Nagayo Town Joint New Water Treatment Plant Development Project"

NJS Corporation, together with a consortium including our group company Fuyo Consultant Co., Ltd. and six other companies (led by Kyowakiden Industry Co., Ltd.), has signed a contract with Nagasaki City and Nagayo Town for the "Nagasaki City and Nagayo Town Joint New Water Treatment Plant Development Project."

To ensure a stable water supply and improve operational efficiency, this project involves consolidating and decommissioning aging facilities—specifically the Urakami Water Treatment Plant (managed by Nagasaki City), the Michino-o Water Treatment Plant (managed by Nagasaki City), and the No. 1 Water Treatment Plant (managed by Nagayo Town)—and constructing a new water treatment plant taking future water demand into account.

The project will be implemented using the DBO (Design-Build-Operate) method.

Project Name: Nagasaki City and Nagayo Town Joint New Water Treatment Plant Development Project

Project Method: DBO (Design-Build-Operate)*

*This method integrates the design, construction, and operation/maintenance of the facility. A Special Purpose Company (SPC) established for the project will take over the operation and maintenance following the facility's completion.

■ Facility Overview

Planned maximum daily water supply capacity: 29,535 m³/day

Water purification method: Upflow biological contact filtration + ceramic membrane filtration

■ Project Period

Design and construction period: February 10, 2026 – March 31, 2033 (7 years)

Operation and maintenance period: April 1, 2033 – March 31, 2048 (15 years)
