◇ Sales Summary

In August, sales showed strong performance despite weather-related challenges such as heavy rain and typhoons. Key drivers included well-received collaborative products in our kids' footwear category, supported by enhanced promotions and successful sales initiatives during the Obon holiday. By product category, sales of sandals, T-shirts, and new sneakers were strong.

All stores sales grew 6.5% to a year ago in this month.

Existing stores sales also showed a year on year growth of 7.0% compared to the same period in the previous year.
