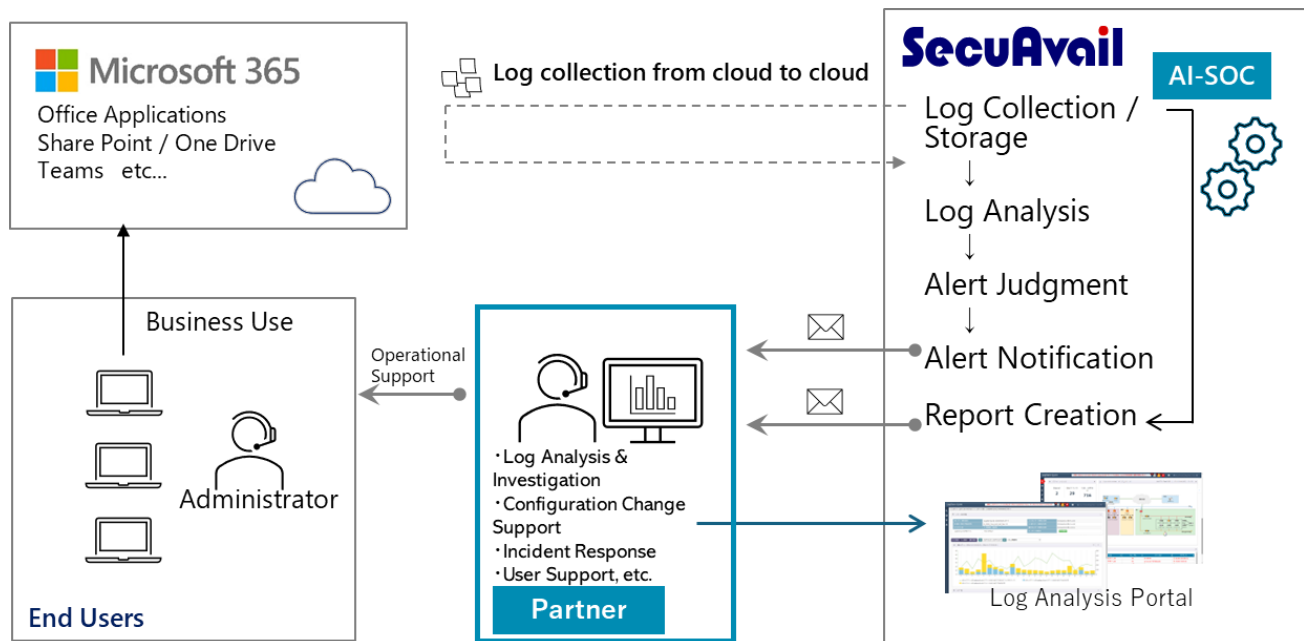
SecuAvail Launches “AI-SOC for M365” Solution Partner Program, Welcomes First Partner

【Explanation of Terms】

AI-SOC

Microsoft 365 (M365)

Microsoft 365 is a subscription service (available on a monthly or annual basis) that bundles Office applications such as Word, Excel, and PowerPoint together with Teams (for meetings and chat), OneDrive (cloud storage), and security features. Delivered via the cloud, it provides users with access to the latest versions of these tools anytime, anywhere. By integrating with Azure (Microsoft's cloud platform) and other services, M365 can enhance the value of medical information—for example, in healthcare, it enables the linkage of electronic medical records used by healthcare professionals with patients' daily lifestyle and health data.
