<Overview of revenue and profit>

The consolidated results for the six months ended September 30, 2025 (April 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025, hereinafter Q2 FY2025) saw year-over-year (hereinafter YoY) 4.0% increase to ¥1,608mn in revenue, driven by continued expansion of its core software business.

Profits also improved, supported by the sustained strong profitability of the Software Business and significant progress in the structural reform of the Investment Business. As a result, operating profit was ¥523mn, profit before income taxes was ¥470mn, and net profit attributable to owners of the parent was ¥418mn.

<Reportable segments>

The company splits its businesses into two reportable segments: the "Software Business segment" and the "Investment Business segment".

Data integration middleware "Warp," recorded revenue of ¥1,382 mn, up 3.0% YoY, supported by solid demand arising from the SAP 2027 issue and the replacement of legacy systems. In addition, the subscription-based(monthly billing) model achieved a 35.0% increase in revenue, further accelerating the stabilization of overall revenue. In August, the Company also launched its iPaaS product "Warp Cloud" and began developing a new adapter compatible with the Japanese-yen-denominated stablecoin JPYC, demonstrating its responsiveness to emerging market needs.

Mobile app building tool "Platio" recorded a 32.4% YoY increase in revenue, driven by growing demand for digitalization of on-site operations and digital transformation (DX) across diverse industries and business sectors. In September, the Company launched "Platio Canvas," an enterprise-oriented product designed for large-scale organizations and departments, further expanding its usage scope.

Furthermore, with the acquisition of MikoSea Inc., a developer of no-code application creation tools, the Company is set to broaden its no-code product portfolio. This will enable it to address not only business use cases but also individual user needs, as it pursues synergies to drive business expansion from the third quarter onward.

Through Asteria Vision Fund I, L.P. (AVF-1), the Group invests in the "D4G" (Data, Device, Decentralized, Design for Green) domain, which aligns with its software business, and recognizes gains or losses on the valuation of investee companies in accordance with IFRS. In the first half, this mainly resulted in the recognition of a valuation gain on SpaceX.

(2) Quarterly explanation of financial position

(Equity)

Overview of Assets, Liabilities and Equity (Assets)

Total assets as of September 30, 2025, were ¥8,192mn, up ¥334mn compared to March 31, 2025. This owed mainly to an increase of ¥420mn in other financial assets and ¥97mn in cash and cash equivalents. (Liabilities)

Total liabilities as of September 30, 2025, were ¥1,677mn, up ¥58mn compared to March 31, 2025. This owed mainly to an increase of ¥104mn in other current liabilities (mainly contract liabilities from business activities) against a decrease of ¥25mn in other current liabilities (lease liabilities).

Total equity as of September 30, 2025, was ¥6,515mn, up ¥276mn compared to March 31, 2025. This owed

mainly to an increase of ¥284mn in retained earnings, ¥279mn in other equity components against a decrease of ¥301mn in treasury stock.

Overview of Cash flows

The balance of cash and cash equivalents (hereinafter "cash") as of September 30, 2025, was ¥2,717mn, down ¥97mn from the end of FY2025.

Change in each cash flow item during the period and the reasons for the changes were as follows.

(Cash flow from operating activities)

Net cash provided by operating activities for Q2 FY2025 was ¥327mn, compared to a cash inflow of ¥558mn in Q2 FY2024. This is mainly attributable to an increase of ¥470mn in profit before income taxes and decrease of ¥191mn in other income (mainly unrealized gains on investments).

(Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash provided in investment activities for Q2 FY2025 was ¥33mn, compared to a cash outflow of ¥797mn in Q2 FY2024. This is mainly due to ¥37mn in proceeds from sales and redemptions of investments. (Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash used in financial activities for Q2 FY2025 was ¥ 465mn, compared to a cash outflow of ¥184mn in Q2 FY2024. This is mainly due to ¥301mn used for the payments for acquisition of treasury shares and ¥134mn used for the payment of dividends.

(3) Outlook for consolidated business results, etc.

There is no change in the consolidated financial results forecast announced on May 14, 2025.
