Selected for the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications' "Demonstration contract for the development of a medical, nursing care and health information sharing system in Singapore" project

Kanamic Network Co., Ltd. (Head office: Shibuya-ku, Tokyo; CEO: Takuma Yamamoto; hereinafter referred to as "the Company") is pleased to announce that its proposal has been selected for the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications' publicly solicited project to "Contract for Demonstration of the Deployment of a Medical, Nursing Care, and Health Information Sharing System in Singapore."

The scale of this project (contract amount) is 113,865,386 yen (tax included), and in addition to surveys and research in Singapore, the work includes demonstration and verification of the cloud system operation in the local environment.

This project aims to verify the usefulness of Japan's information sharing system for health, medical care, and nursing care in Singapore, where the population is rapidly aging, with the aim of overseas expansion and securing an international competitive advantage. Singapore has launched the Healthier SG in July 2023, a preventive medical initiative for citizens aged 60 and over, and this demonstration is expected to contribute to this initiative.

In this project, the company will promote the demonstration by leveraging the following strengths:

- Extensive implementation track record and expertise: Our Kanamic Cloud Service is a multi-disciplinary collaboration cloud service that supports Japan's community-based integrated care system and has been implemented in over 1,300 regions and more than 50,000 businesses nationwide, providing us with many years of operational experience and specialized know-how in medical and nursing care collaboration.

Our representative director and president, Takuma Yamamoto, also serves as the representative of TWM, enabling us to act quickly and effectively.




Fig1. Differences in the DX business field between Japan and Singapore

Through this business, we will verify that Japan's advanced DX model in the fields of medical care, nursing care, and health is applicable and useful in Singapore, and in the future aim to expand this model to the entire ASEAN region (Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam, etc.) from Singapore as a base. This will contribute to resolving social issues faced by ASEAN countries, such as a shortage of medical and nursing care personnel and rising medical costs in their super-aging societies, and will achieve both "social contribution and economic profit," while also contributing to strengthening the international competitiveness of Japan's medical and nursing care industry.

Singapore is experiencing a similar aging trend to Japan, lagging about 20 years behind.

In major ASEAN countries and India, life expectancy is increasing due to factors such as rising economic standards and advances in medical systems. Meanwhile, when looking at Singapore's total fertility rate, it is significantly lower than that of Japan, where a declining birthrate and aging population are becoming a social issue, meaning there will be fewer citizens to support society in the future. However, the population itself continues to grow due to the influx of foreigners. Looking at the social security systems of Southeast Asian countries, only Singapore has a nursing care insurance system. As the aging population becomes more serious in the future, it is expected that there will be increased efforts to improve social security, and this is expected to accelerate in Singapore and Thailand, where the problem is particularly severe.




Fig3. Kanamic Network's outlook for overseas expansion




Fig4. Kanamic Network Growth Strategy through 2030
