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## 1. Overview of Operating Results, etc.

### (1) Overview of operating results for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2025

Forward-looking statements in this document reflect GMO Financial Gate Group (GMO-FG) judgements as of the end of the cumulative consolidated first quarter of the fiscal year ending September 2026.

Financial results for the cumulative consolidated first quarter of the fiscal year ending September 2026 (October 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025) are as follows:

#### a. Revenue

Revenue reached ¥4,942,846 thousand (up 7.8% YoY).

During the three months ended December 31, 2025, the use of cashless payments increased, driven by greater adoption of our cashless platform by merchants in industries and business categories frequently used in life necessities and higher spending associated with the year-end holiday season sales campaign. As a result, the use of our offline cashless payment platform expanded, and the transaction volume and Gross Merchandise Value (GMV), the Company's primary KPIs, showed strong growth.

Recurring-model revenue showed steady growth in stock and fee revenues, supported by sustained growth in payment activity in the life necessities domain, including household goods stores, large commercial facilities, and drugstores, and also by our ability to capture the surge in demand during the year-end holiday season sales campaign. Spread revenue achieved stronger-than-expected sales growth due to steady progress in acquiring small and medium-sized merchants (SMEs) and merchants in the leisure and amusement sector.

Sales of payment terminals, which account for most of initial revenue, achieved growth primarily through projects for large-scale commercial facilities and SMEs. However, this was insufficient to offset the impact of large projects for household goods stores recorded in the three months ended December 31, 2024.

Revenue by business model for the three months ended December 31, 2025 is as follows. Recurring-model revenue consists of stock, fee and spread revenues, and figures in parenthesis represent a breakdown of recurring-model revenue.

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b. Operating profit

Operating profit reached ¥954,695 thousand (up 15.3% YoY).

Compared to the three months ended December 31, 2024, the positives were an increase in higher margin recurring-model revenue due to an increase in the number of payments processed and GMV, whereas the negatives included a decrease in profitable development revenue. Progress toward our operating profit plans remains on track for both the first half and the full year.

c. Profit before income taxes

Profit before income taxes reached ¥951,933 thousand (up 14.8% YoY).

(2) Overview of financial position as of December 31, 2025

[1] Overview of assets, liabilities and net assets

(Assets)

As of December 31, 2025, current assets increased ¥2,269,702 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥13,122,353 thousand. This was mainly due to increases in merchandise of ¥1,003,829 thousand, in cash and cash equivalents of ¥727,668 thousand and in other current assets of ¥518,676 thousand. The increase in merchandise is due to strategic stockpiling in preparation for deliveries associated with upcoming large projects. Non-current assets increased ¥88,901 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥3,068,733 thousand mainly due to an increase in goodwill and intangible assets despite decreases in deferred tax assets of ¥121,246 thousand and in property, plant and equipment of ¥36,187 thousand.

As a result, total assets increased ¥2,358,603 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥16,191,086 thousand.

(Liabilities)

As of December 31, 2025, current liabilities increased ¥2,521,436 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥7,807,913 thousand. This was mainly due to an increase in borrowings of ¥3,000,000 thousand, which was undertaken to ensure financial stability and maintain adequate liquidity in anticipation of working capital needs related mainly to expected future terminal purchases. Non-current liabilities decreased ¥2,171 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥2,049,488 thousand mainly due to decreases in deferred tax liabilities of ¥1,424 thousand and in other financial liabilities of ¥846 thousand.

As a result, total liabilities increased ¥2,519,265 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥9,857,401 thousand.

(Net assets)

As of December 31, 2025, total net assets decreased ¥160,661 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥6,333,685 thousand. This was mainly because retained earnings decreased ¥817,224 thousand due to distribution of dividend from surplus despite an increase in retained earnings of ¥653,915 thousand due to recording of profit attributable to owners of parent.

[2] Overview of cash flows

As of December 31, 2025, cash and cash equivalents ("cash") increased ¥727,668 thousand from September 30, 2025 to ¥4,984,944 thousand.

A summary of cash flows from each activity for the three months ended December 31, 2025 is as follows.

(Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash used in operating activities was ¥1,000,414 thousand (net cash used of ¥149,426 thousand for the three months ended December 31, 2024) mainly because cash decreased due to an increase in inventory of ¥1,003,829 thousand, an increase in deposits received of ¥515,537 thousand, and a decrease in other liabilities of ¥383,380 thousand while cash increased due to recording of profit before income taxes of ¥951,933 thousand.

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(Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used in investing activities was ¥420,992 thousand (net cash used of ¥225,901 thousand for the three months ended December 31, 2024) mainly because cash decreased due to purchase of intangible assets of ¥289,938 thousand and payments associated with a business combination of ¥128,400 thousand.

(Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash provided in financing activities was ¥2,149,075 thousand (net cash used of ¥1,031,827 thousand for the three months ended December 31, 2024) mainly because cash increased due to an increase in short term borrowings of ¥3,000,000 thousand while cash decreased due to payment of dividends of ¥814,653 thousand.

**(3) Overview of consolidated financial forecast and other forward-looking information**

There is no change in the consolidated financial forecast for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 from those previously released on November 13, 2025 at this point. In the offline cashless payment market in which the Group operates, the trend of increase in cashless payments continued due to government-led promotion and diversifying payment methods. As a result, the government's target of achieving a 40% cashless payment ratio in Japan by 2025 is expected to be fulfilled ahead of schedule, with steady momentum toward the long-term goal of reaching 80%. Under such an environment, the Group aims to continue medium and long-term growth in revenue and operating profit by focusing on sales of payment terminals meeting the needs of merchants, enhancement of payment processing centers, and acquisition of new merchants and alliance partners.

The consolidated financial forecast for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 is revenue of ¥19,730 million (up 10.1% YoY), operating profit of ¥2,800 million (up 25.5% YoY), profit before income taxes of ¥2,782 million (up 25.1% YoY), profit of ¥1,874 million (up 16.6% YoY) and profit attributable to owners of parent of ¥1,870 million (up 14.6% YoY).

Through a series of transactions based on the agreement concluded on August 8, 2025 between the Company and TakeMe Co., Ltd. ("TakeMe"), effective October 1, 2025, we have succeeded the rights and obligations related to the restaurant operation support/mobile order business which is operated by TakeMe by way of an absorption-type company split ("Company Split"). Through the Company Split, we aim to further advance our cashless platform as well as seek to enhance the value of services offered to our member merchants and also drive our medium- to long-term corporate value.
