[Toyokumo, Inc.] OSS Developer Support Program "Thanks OSS Award":

7 New Recipients Selected in the First Half of 2026, Bringing Total Support to \$280,000

Toyokumo, Inc. (Headquarters: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Yuji Yamamoto; hereinafter, Toyokumo), a SaaS company providing easy-to-use cloud services for business, has selected the recipients for its "Thanks OSS Award" program for the first half of 2026 (January–June), which supports open-source software (OSS) developers. **A total of \$31,090 was provided to 11 individuals and 1 organization** this time, bringing the total accumulated support **since the program's inception in 2022 to \$282,317** (approximately 4,500 million yen *1).

Many OSS projects, which serve as essential technical infrastructure for SaaS offerings, rely on uncompensated development by individuals, leading to issues such as dependency on specific individuals for maintenance and lack of funding. Toyokumo continues to provide funding of approximately 10 million yen (annual Japanese yen equivalent) to encourage OSS developers to continue their development as before.

The use of OSS is indispensable for software development, including SaaS. However, many OSS projects are developed and maintained by individual volunteers, and the increasing support demands resulting from a growing user base can sometimes become a barrier to continued development. Recognizing its dependence on OSS technology for product development, Toyokumo continually provides financial support totaling approximately 10 million yen annually, which is an estimated annual salary for one software engineer.

Summary of Support for the First Half of 2026

- **Support Period:** January–June 2026
- **Total Support Amount:** \$31,090
- **Recipients:** 11 OSS developers and 1 organization (including 7 new additions)
- **Method of Support:** Primarily provided as a lump-sum donation via "GitHub Sponsors"
- **Cumulative Support Amount:** \$282,317 (Total from 2022 to the first half of 2026)

Midori	Vite	A fast front-end build tool. Contributes to the development of the ecosystem through numerous contributions.
Ken'ichiro Oyama	deck	A tool that generates Google Slides from Markdown files, automating and increasing the efficiency of document creation.
Boshen	Oxlint, Oxfmt	A Rust-based JavaScript/TypeScript toolchain that improves processing speed in front-end development.
Nuno Maduro	Pint	A tool for automatically fixing PHP code styles, contributing to the maintenance of code quality and reduction of development costs.
Devon Govett	Lightning CSS	A fast CSS parser and transformer that also functions as a dependency for Tailwind CSS.
Tomáš Votruba	Rector	A static analysis tool that automates PHP refactoring, contributing to the improved maintainability of legacy code.

Mickaël Schoentgen	Watchdog	A Python library for monitoring file system events, operating as the basis for many development tools.
