### **(Progress of disclosure) Notice Concerning the Court Decision on the Litigation Against Our Company**

ENECHANGE (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”) hereby inform you that, as disclosed in the "Notice Concerning Litigation Filed Against Our Company" dated December 13, 2024, a damages lawsuit (hereinafter referred to as "this lawsuit") was filed against us by Terra Charge Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Terra") on November 29 of the same year. Today, a judgment has been rendered in this lawsuit.

#### **1. Court Rendering the Decision and Date of Judgment**

#### **3. Background of the lawsuit filing and the court decision**

On November 29, 2024, the Company was sued by Terra for damages (claim amount: 510 million JPY and delayed damages). The allegations are: (1) statements made by our former CEO, Yohei Kiguchi, during a Q&A session at the Financial Results Briefing for individual investors held in February 2024, which is published on our website, constitute tort and unfair competition acts; (2) our company engaged in unjust interference with the aim of withdrawing investments or loans concerning investment or loan agreements between Terra and its business partners, which also constitutes a tort.

In response, the Company has asserted and proven our legitimacy, claiming that Terra's allegations are unfounded.

#### **4. Overview of the court decision**

Reject the plaintiff's claim.

The Company understands that the validity of us has been fully acknowledged. There is no change to our forecast for the consolidated financial results for the financial year ending March 2026.
