Take and Give Needs and RIHGA Royal Hotel Kyoto to begin Business Partnership in Wedding Services from January 2026

Tokyo-based wedding company Take and Give Needs Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Kenji Iwase; hereinafter referred to as “the Company”) is pleased to announce a strategic partnership with RRH Kyoto Operations LLC (Headquarters: Shimogyo-ku, Kyoto City; Executive Officer: Hideki Funayama) regarding the wedding business of RIHGA Royal Hotel Kyoto (Location: Shiokoji Street, Higashihorikawa-dori, Shimogyo-ku, Kyoto City; General Manager: Tomoyuki Fujii), operated by RRH Kyoto Operations LLC, effective January 2026.



The Company operates approximately 60 directly managed guesthouses throughout Japan and is expanding its consulting and management outsourcing services for other facilities, mainly hotels. Since forming a partnership with Tokyo Kaikan in 2017, the Company has continued to grow its consulting portfolio, including the Sendai Royal Park Hotel (consulting begins October this year), Yokohama Grand Intercontinental Hotel, RIHGA Royal Hotel Hiroshima, RIHGA Royal Hotel Kokura, and Nishitetsu Grand Hotel in Fukuoka. These partnerships have led to improved performance across multiple venues.

The newly partnered RIHGA Royal Hotel Kyoto is a prestigious and traditional hotel that has been beloved in Kyoto for over 55 years since its opening in 1969. Located about a 7-minute walk from Kyoto Station, it offers excellent access to World Heritage sites such as Toji Temple and Nishi Honganji Temple. The hotel

features a wide variety of restaurants and bars, including Japan's only revolving observation French restaurant with views of the historic cityscape and night scenery, as well as banquet halls of various sizes and 489 guest rooms, serving both tourists and locals alike.

The Company has its expertise gained from handling approximately 12,000 weddings annually—the highest number in Japan—along with the latest wedding trend insights, human resources, system infrastructure, and regional wedding data. By combining this with its extensive consulting experience at external partner facilities, the Company aims to enhance the value of the wedding business at RIHGA Royal Hotel Kyoto.
