TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO set to open September 2027

The brand unveils a first look at the hotel's design concepts and facilities, including TRUNK(HOTEL)'s debut spa experience

TAKE AND GIVE. NEEDS Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Kenji Iwase) is pleased to announce that, its group subsidiary, TRUNK Co., Ltd., developer of the TRUNK(HOTEL) brand (headquarters: Shibuya-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Yoshitaka Nojiri), has decided on 17 September 2027 as the opening date for TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO, which will open in Sapporo, Hokkaido.

Ahead of the hotel's opening, wedding consultations and reservations will be accepted starting in August 2026.



TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO will mark the brand's first property outside of its home base of Tokyo, following TRUNK(HOTEL) CAT STREET, TRUNK(HOUSE), and TRUNK(HOTEL) YOYOGI PARK. The hotel will continue TRUNK's localized approach to hospitality, grounding the guest experience in a deep understanding of its locale - from its landscape, history, and culture, to its character and traditions.

TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO will be located in the heart of Sapporo, in the Odori district, and will present the group's debut spa experience - 'TRUNK(BATH HOUSE)'. The hotel will also feature an outpost of the acclaimed Sushi Saito restaurant and an all-day dining restaurant offering local Hokkaido cuisine, banquet rooms, and a lounge and bar hosting a program of live entertainment.



TRUNK(BATH HOUSE) will offer a total of ten unique bathing spaces, inviting guests to relax and unwind. The spa experience will begin in a reception area that opens onto a waterway, guiding guests seamlessly into the bathing rooms. Ten bathing environments have been designed to stimulate the senses through subtle variations in temperature, light, and sound. Large communal baths, high-temperature saunas, cold-water baths, and open-air relaxation spaces will further enhance the experience.

TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO Additional Facilities

● Sushi Saito Restaurant (10th Floor)

Sushi Saito, the famed Edo-style sushi bar which has captivated gourmands the world over, will open an outpost within TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO. By combining traditional Tokyo sushi technique with ingredients and cuisine unique to Hokkaido, the restaurant will create a distinctive sushi offering that reflects the flavors of the region. Counter seating will invite guests to watch the chefs craft each piece of artisanal sushi.

About Sushi Saito

Foodies from around the world congregate at Sushi Saito, the famed Edo-style sushi bar, in pursuit of the uncompromising excellence in every piece of sushi crafted by owner Takashi Saito. The restaurant was awarded three stars for ten consecutive years by the Tokyo Michelin Guide in its 2010 through 2019 editions. Though ineligible for listing after it stopped taking reservations from the public and became members-only, Sushi Saito continues to be widely hailed as Japan's hardest-to-book sushi restaurant. In 2024, TRUNK Co., Ltd., formed a partnership with the restaurant to help spread Japan's proud culture of sushi globally, starting with a restaurant at TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO.

● Guest Rooms (13th Floor – 18th Floor)

The design of the hotel's 107 guest rooms (89 standard rooms + 18 suites) will draw on Hokkaido's local craft traditions and natural materials, presented from a contemporary perspective.



- **Lounge & Bar (10th Floor)**

The TRUNK(HOTEL) SAPPORO Lounge & Bar will be a comfortable environment in which to enjoy a vibrant program of live music, drinks and dining. An outdoor terrace, complemented by private domed spaces, will offer guests expansive views of Sapporo and its changing seasonal landscapes.



- **All Day Dining Restaurant (10th Floor)**

The all-day dining restaurant will present a varied menu that showcases seasonal ingredients local to Hokkaido and its rich natural environment.



- **Private Studio Spaces (10th Floor)**

A multi-purpose space that can be freely adapted to suit any purpose or occasion, housing a cinema, karaoke room, and multi-function room. It caters to a wide range of uses, from celebrations to private moments with loved ones to business events.



- **CHAPEL (10th Floor)**

A chapel with an open, airy feel and ceilings soaring to six meters. Built from natural materials in a simple, modern style, the space is filled with sunlight from expansive windows, with lush greenery unfolding just beyond. Though set in the heart of the city, it offers an intimate connection to light, greenery, and natural textures.



- **Banquet Rooms (10th Floor – 11th Floor)**

Three banquet halls will be available on-site: HINATA, a bright space filled with natural light; MIYABI, inspired by historic European halls; and KODACHI, a space surrounded by forestry. The three halls will offer a variety of settings for weddings, parties, business meetings, and other events. Bespoke menus will be crafted to suit each space and complemented by facilities such as a dessert room, sushi counter, and terrace with a pizza oven.
