

Subsidiary InfiniVAN Sponsors NPO ACTION's School Lunch Support Program in the Philippines

Our telecommunications subsidiary, InfiniVAN, Inc. (Headquarters: Philippines; President: Shigeki Nakahara; hereinafter "InfiniVAN"), will sponsor a school lunch program in the Philippines organized by ACTION, Inc. (hereinafter "ACTION"), a nonprofit organization based in Musashino City, Tokyo, Japan, as part of our ongoing initiatives to address social issues. ACTION has been engaged in supporting children in underprivileged communities in the Philippines, and this program is designed to provide nutritious school meals to elementary school students.

In the Philippines, recent increases in living costs have severely impacted the nutritional status of children in impoverished areas. As part of our efforts to contribute to society, our group aim to support this program through our sponsorship, albeit in a small way, to help improve the nutritional status of children in the Philippines.

On August 29, 2025, an opening ceremony was held for the "Akamegane Kitchen (Red Glasses Canteen)," established as a venue for school meals at Tanza Elementary School in Navotas City, Metro Manila, which is the target of the support program.

The main activities of InfiniVAN in this program are as follows.

[Target] Tanza Elementary School[Location] Navotas City, Metro Manila[Target] Nutrition support for 8 students (for one year)

- Establishment of the "Akamegane Kitchen" at a Philippine elementary school
- Support of 2,000 Philippine pesos (approximately 5,500 yen, equivalent to 20 meals) per student per month, totaling 24,000 pesos annually
- Implementation of nutrition improvement guidance for students and their parents







Navotas City is located in the northwestern part of Metro Manila, with fishing as its primary industry. It is also one of the most flood-prone areas in the Philippines. The city is home to slum areas, which are symbolic of poverty. Tanza Elementary School is situated in a district that includes low-income housing for residents affected by typhoons and other disasters, and addressing malnutrition among students is a key challenge.

Akamegane Kitchen serves as a safe and comfortable space for children to enjoy their meals. The initiative collaborates with a company that manufactures boxed lunches and rice balls for major convenience stores, which delivers meat, vegetables, and seasonings to Akamegane Kitchen weekly. These ingredients are then cooked in the school's kitchen. Through these efforts, the initiative has reduced food procurement costs and enabled efficient operations with a small staff. With the support of numerous sponsor companies, ACTION has provided a cumulative total of 1.5 million meals annually to 100–140 children.

Our group aims to contribute to the economic and social development of the Philippines through the development of communication infrastructure. We deeply appreciate your ongoing understanding and support. We will continue to strive to give back to the Philippines.
