Appointment of Dr. Noriyuki Tomiyama as CMO of HIMEDIC, Inc. and Implementation Framework for Our Remote Diagnostic Imaging Service

Resorttrust, Inc. today announced that it will be implementing an organizational restructuring aimed at strengthening the capabilities of the Resorttrust Group's diagnostic imaging and remote diagnostic imaging service, as detailed below.

We are pleased to welcome Dr. Noriyuki Tomiyama, professor emeritus of the University of Osaka and former President of the Japan Radiological Society, as Executive Officer and Chief Medical Officer (CMO) of HIMEDIC, Inc. (President, Ariyoshi Fushimi ; headquarters, Shibuya-ku, Tokyo), which operates the Grand HIMEDIC Club, as Grand HIMEDIC Club Chairman of the Board, and as Director of iMedical Inc. Furthermore, we will make iMedical Inc., currently a consolidated subsidiary of Resorttrust, Inc., a direct subsidiary of HIMEDIC, Inc. effective September 30, 2026.

This organizational restructuring aims to strengthen the diagnostic imaging service within our group's Medical Segment and accelerate new-value generation in the medical ICT field by bringing together the medical screenings and preventive healthcare services centered on the diagnostic imaging technology that HIMEDIC, Inc. has developed over three decades since its establishment in 1994 and iMedical Inc.'s remote image diagnosis support service to operate them in an integrated manner under the guidance of Professor Emeritus Tomiyama.

1. Positions to Be Filled by Professor Emeritus Noriyuki Tomiyama

- Chairman of the Board, Grand HIMEDIC Club
- Executive Officer and Chief Medical Officer (CMO), HIMEDIC, Inc.
- Director, iMedical Inc.

In his capacity as listed above, Dr. Tomiyama will serve as the Chief Medical Officer in the field of diagnostic imaging at the Grand HIMEDIC Club to lead the club's work to improve the quality of diagnostic imaging. He will also supervise the operation of remote image diagnosis, which is conducted in 1.35 million cases annually at HIMEDIC's investee companies, including iMedical Inc., its subsidiary Cent-Medical Associates Inc., and Kyoto ProMed Co., Ltd., 33.8% of which is owned by HIMEDIC.

The Grand HIMEDIC Club Board of Directors, with Dr. Tomiyama as the new chairman, is comprised of top-class medical experts in Japan, primarily in the field of radiology (including Keio University Professor Emeritus Sachio Kuribayashi, Aichi Medical University Professor Emeritus Tsuneo Ishiguchi, University of Osaka Professor Emeritus Hironobu Nakamura, and University of Osaka Professor Emeritus Yoshiki Sawa). This board will oversee the quality of the Grand HIMEDIC Club's membership-based medical services from a medical perspective.

Having spearheaded radiology in Japan and the Asia and Oceania region for many years, Dr. Tomiyama is a leading expert in the field of radiological diagnosis in Japan.

3. Background and Significance of the Latest Changes

(1) Further advancement of the diagnostic imaging capabilities of HIMEDIC, a pioneer in health checkups and preventive medicine

Working with its partner medical institutions, HIMEDIC, Inc. introduced a membership-based screening service utilizing positron emission tomography (PET) — the first service of its kind in Japan — in 1994, when the concept of cancer screening was yet to gain wide recognition. Since then, it has developed a diagnostic imaging program known as the Yamanakako Method, making it a pioneer in screening and preventive medicine. Over three decades since then, the company has expanded its operations to 14 locations in the Tokyo, Yokohama, Nagoya, Kyoto, and Osaka areas through collaboration with partner medical institutions, with its membership now totaling some 36,000.

With Dr. Tomiyama, a leading expert in the field of radiological diagnosis, joining as Chief Medical Officer, HIMEDIC will strive to further elevate the quality of our cancer early detection program, which utilizes diagnostic imaging equipment including PET/CT and PET/MRI.

(2) Pursuit of business synergies through the change in control structure for iMedical Inc.

iMedical Inc. was established in June 2013 as a joint venture between the Resorttrust Group and Mitsui&Co., Ltd. (IT & Communication Business Unit) with the aim of promoting remote diagnostic imaging and medical ICT. Mitsui&Co., Ltd.'s IT & Communication Business Unit leverages its ICT expertise in areas such as AI, data utilization, and cybersecurity to promote improvements in medical quality and convenience in the healthcare and drug discovery fields. It serves as a joint venture partner of iMedical Inc.

The remote image diagnosis support service provided by iMedical Inc. and its subsidiary, Cent-Medical Associates Inc., has grown into one of the largest of the services of this kind in Japan.

By making iMedical Inc. a direct subsidiary of HIMEDIC, Inc., and in conjunction with HIMEDIC, Inc.'s existing 33.8% stake in Kyoto ProMed Co., Ltd., which is affiliated with Kyoto University, we will consolidate our group's diagnostic imaging-related functions under HIMEDIC, Inc.

This will allow us to achieve the following:

- Further improvement of the quality of diagnostic imaging service for Grand HIMEDIC Club members
- Ensuring a stable supply of radiological diagnosis specialists, a resource that is in short supply nationwide, within our group
- Advancement of diagnostic services utilizing AI for diagnostic imaging in the medical ICT field

(3) Creating new value in medical ICT field

The Resorttrust Group has been promoting initiatives to utilize healthcare data through our group companies. Taking the opportunity of the latest shift that made Medical Inc. into a direct subsidiary of HIMEDIC, Inc., we aim to create new value in the following areas, while utilizing, as appropriate, not only the medical ICT infrastructure of our group but also the global ICT network and expertise of Mitsui&Co., Ltd. (IT & Communication Business Unit), which is

Medical Inc.'s joint venture partner.

- Improving the efficiency and sophistication of diagnostic imaging service using AI for diagnostic imaging
- Research and development of new medical and nursing care operations utilizing medical ICT technology

(4) Securing human capital to ensure medium- to long-term growth of the Medical Segment

The medium- to long-term growth of our group's Medical Segment depends significantly on securing medical staff, including doctors, nurses, technicians, and medical concierges—in other words, human capital. The latest organizational restructuring is an important step for us in securing a core resource for our health checkup business, specifically radiological diagnosis, within our group, thereby guaranteeing business growth.

4. Overview of the Resorttrust Group's Medical Segment

The group's Medical Segment (medical business and senior residence business) is a comprehensive medical platform comprised of the following operations:

- ① Members-only comprehensive medical support association: HIMEDIC, Inc. / Grand HIMEDIC Club
- ② Remote image diagnosis support business: iMedical Inc., Cent-Medical Associates Inc., and Kyoto ProMed Co., Ltd.
- ③ Medical institution operation support (Medical Service Corporation) business: Support for the operation of general health checkup/medical examination facilities, outpatient clinics, cancer treatment, dental clinics, etc.
- ④ Advanced medical care and aesthetic medicine business: Boron neutron capture therapy (BNCT), regenerative medicine, and aesthetic medicine services including anti-aging care
- ⑤ Well-being products business: Cosmetics, supplements, femcare items, etc.
- ⑥ Senior residence business: Trust Garden, Himedic Residence The Garden
- ⑦ International business: Overseas expansion of the above know-how

Under our brand identity of “Together for a Wonderful Life,” the Resorttrust Group aims to contribute to improving “healthy longevity in the age of 100-year life,” which is customers' lifelong health value, by building a medical platform that provides everything from prevention and diagnosis to treatment and aftercare in an integrated manner.
