## **Notification Regarding the Fire at Tianjin Factory**

SMC Corporation (SMC) hereby inform you about the Fire that occurred at our consolidated subsidiary, SMC (Tianjin) Manufacturing Co., Ltd. located in Tianjin, China (hereinafter referred to as the “Tianjin Factory”) at 15:40 on March 23, 2026, China Standard Time (UTC+8).

### **1) Damage**

Seven employees engaged in the initial firefighting response sustained injuries and were treated at a hospital. None of the injuries are considered serious.

Building for surface finishing of Tianjin Factory, which is one of the eight buildings currently in operation, was damaged by fire and has become unusable. Restoration is expected to require a prolonged period.

Due to firefighting activities and inspection by the fire department, operations at the entire Tianjin Factory were temporarily suspended but resumed on March 25.

### **2) Cause of Fire**

The cause of the fire is still under investigation; however, it is believed that a hanger used in the anodizing process overheated and ignited nearby combustible materials.

### **3) Impact on Production Activities**

There is no disruption to the production or shipments, as alternative production has been implemented in accordance with the Company’s BCP (Business Continuity Plan).

For products destined for the domestic Chinese market, the anodizing and painting process will be handled by extending the operation at the Beijing Factory.

For the other products, production will be managed by adjusting production setup and extending operation at the Vietnam Factory.

### **4) Impact on Business Performance**

The impact on business performance is negligible.
