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Management Performance and Financial Conditions

(1) Outline of Operations and Business Results

In April 2025, Komatsu Ltd. ("Company") and its consolidated subsidiaries (together "Komatsu") launched a three-year medium-term management plan - the Strategic Growth Plan - titled "Driving value with ambition", which covers the period up to the fiscal year ending March 2028. Under the plan, Komatsu upholds three pillars of growth strategies: 1) Create customer value through innovation; 2) Drive growth and profitability; and 3) Transform our business foundation. And, we are working to further evolve the value of our products and solutions with an aim of realizing its redefined vision of becoming a collaborative partner committed to optimizing safe, productive, and clean workplaces.

For the first six-month period (April 1- September 30, 2025) of the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026, the first year of the Strategic Growth Plan, consolidated net sales totaled JPY 1,891.6 billion, a decrease of 3.9% from the corresponding period a year ago. In the construction, mining and utility equipment business, despite our efforts to improve the selling prices, sales decreased from the corresponding period a year ago due to the appreciation of the Japanese yen compared to the corresponding period a year ago and reduced sales volume. In the industrial machinery and others business, sales increased from the corresponding period a year ago, supported primarily by increased sales of large presses for the automobile manufacturing industry and increased maintenance revenues in the excimer laser-related business for the semiconductor industry.

With respect to profits for the first six-month period under review, despite our efforts to improve the selling prices in the construction, mining and utility equipment business, profits decreased, primarily due to a decrease in sales volume, the Japanese yen's appreciation and a cost increase. In the retail finance and industrial machinery and others business, profits increased. As a result, operating income totaled JPY 277.1 billion, a decrease of 8.7% from the corresponding period a year ago. The operating income ratio decreased by 0.8 percentage point from the corresponding period a year ago to 14.6%. Income before income taxes and equity in earnings of affiliated companies decreased by 7.3% from the corresponding period a year ago to JPY 258.4 billion. Net income attributable to Komatsu Ltd. decreased by 12.9% from the corresponding period a year ago to JPY 175.7 billion.

Business results by operation are described below.

Construction, Mining and Utility Equipment

For the first six-month period under review, sales of the construction, mining, and utility equipment business decreased by 4.8% from the corresponding period a year ago, to JPY 1,742.2 billion. Segment profit decreased by 13.0% to JPY 242.0 billion.

During the period under review, Komatsu steadily promoted Smart Construction, a digital solution for construction sites and the "rate of ICT machine adoption," which indicates the sales ratio of ICT construction equipment in Japan, the U.S., Europe, and Australia, marked 27.0%. With respect to mining equipment, the cumulative total number of Autonomous Haulage System (AHS) mining trucks reached 940 units as of the end of September, 2025.

With regard to construction equipment business, EARTHBRAIN Ltd. started collaborating with TIER IV Inc. The collaboration will focus on autonomous operation of dump-trucks, aiming to achieve practical use of the automated driving system by FY2027.

In mining equipment business, Komatsu started collaborating with Applied Intuition. This collaboration aims to provide cutting-edge technologies and real-time adaptability to Komatsu's next generation mining equipment, helping customers boost productivity, reduce downtime and operate with greater precision and efficiency.

Komatsu's operations by region are described below.

Americas

In North America, while the impact of U.S. tariff policy on demand was not clearly observed and demand for construction equipment for energy-related sectors and infrastructure development remained steady, sales decreased by 7.6% from the corresponding period a year ago, mainly due to decreased sales of mining equipment and the Japanese yen's appreciation.

In Latin America, despite the effects of the Japanese yen's appreciation, sales remained nearly flat from the corresponding period a year ago (an increase of 0.5%), supported by increased sales of mining equipment in Chile as mainly affected by steady demand in copper.

Europe, Africa and Middle East

In Europe, demand remained steady from the first quarter, supported by improved economic sentiment resulting from the European Central Bank's rate cuts, and sales of construction equipment increased. As a result, sales increased by 6.2% from the corresponding period a year ago.

In Africa, sales increased by 7.0% from the corresponding period a year ago, supported by increased sales of mining equipment.

In the Middle East, despite weak demand resulting from a decline in crude oil prices in Saudi Arabia, demand related to large-scale infrastructure projects in the United Arab Emirates remained steady. As a result, sales increased by 20.7% from the corresponding period a year ago.

Oceania, Asia and CIS

In Oceania, although sales of mining equipment increased, sales decreased by 6.0% from the corresponding period a year ago, due to the Japanese yen's appreciation.

^{*2}Excluding Japan

In Asia, sales decreased by 21.2% from the corresponding period a year ago, mainly affected by a decrease in demand resulting from factors such as sluggish coal prices as well as a reduction in budgets for infrastructure development in Indonesia, the largest market in the region.

In China, sales decreased by 11.4% from the corresponding period a year ago, mainly due to the continued sluggish real estate market conditions.

In CIS, sales decreased by 12.7% from the corresponding period a year ago due to decreased sales of mining equipment in Central Asia.

Japan

In Japan, despite the effect of expanded sales of a new model of hydraulic excavator, PC200i/210-12, demand for both rental and non-rental use remained weak. As a result, sales decreased by 6.5% from the corresponding period a year ago.

Retail Finance

For the first six-month period under review, while interest income increased, revenues decreased by 1.3% from the corresponding period a year ago, to JPY 61.0 billion due to the Japanese yen's appreciation. Segment profit increased by 13.9% to JPY 16.9 billion, mainly supported by a reduction in funding costs.

Industrial Machinery and Others

For the first six-month period under review, sales increased by 10.5% from the corresponding period a year ago, to JPY 106.9 billion, mainly supported by increased sales of large presses for the automobile manufacturing industry and increased maintenance revenues in the excimer laser-related business for the semiconductor industry. Segment profit amounted to JPY 16.6 billion, an increase of 112.1%.

(2) Financial Conditions

As of September 30, 2025, total assets increased by JPY 149.0 billion from the previous fiscal year-end, to JPY 5,922.5 billion, as mainly affected by the Japanese yen's depreciation against major currencies other than the U.S. dollar and increased inventories. Interest-bearing debt increased by JPY 125.4 billion from the previous fiscal year-end, to JPY 1,276.0 billion. Komatsu Ltd. shareholders' equity increased by JPY 44.0 billion from the previous fiscal year-end, to JPY 3,217.4 billion. As a result, Komatsu Ltd. shareholders' equity ratio decreased by 0.7 percentage points from the previous fiscal year-end, to 54.3%.

For the first six-month period under review, although inventories increased, net cash provided in operating activities totaled JPY 127.7 billion, a decrease of JPY 90.0 billion from the corresponding period a year ago, mainly due to net income for the period. Net cash used in investing activities amounted to JPY 94.2 billion, a decrease of JPY 10.2 billion, mainly due to the purchase of fixed assets. Net cash used in financing activities amounted to JPY 71.5 billion (as compared to JPY 96.4 billion used for the corresponding period a year ago), mainly due to buyback of common stock and payment of dividends. After adding the effects of foreign exchange fluctuations to the total amount of each cash flow, as of September 30, 2025, cash and cash equivalents totaled JPY 345.2 billion, a decrease of JPY 40.4 billion from the previous fiscal year-end.

(3) Projection for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 2026

(From April 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026)

Komatsu has revised projected consolidated sales and profits for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 to reflect the Japanese yen's more-than-anticipated depreciation, as well as the impact of U.S. tariffs and the latest market outlook.

Komatsu has reviewed the exchange rates assumed in its projection and revised the average exchange rates for the second six-month period as follows: (USD1=JPY 140.0, EUR1=JPY 163.0, and AUD1=JPY 91.0). With respect to average exchange rates for the full year, Komatsu now estimates them as follows: USD 1=JPY 143.2, EUR 1=JPY 164.9, and AUD 1=JPY 92.7 (Initial assumption: USD 1=JPY 135.0, EUR 1=JPY 150.0 and AUD 1=JPY 84.0).
