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1. Results of Operations

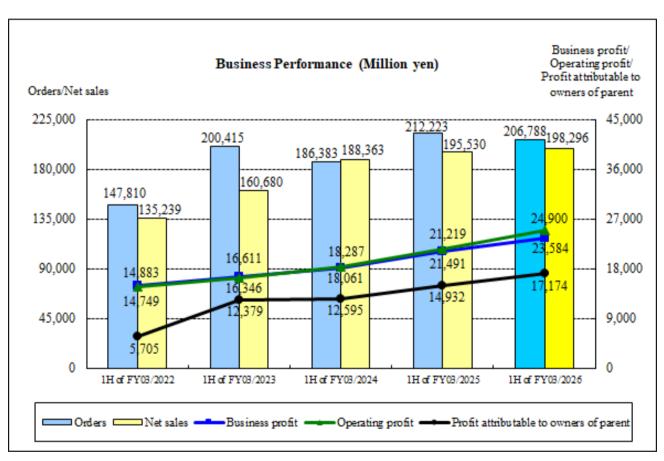
- (1) Results of Operations
 - 1) Six Months Ended September 30, 2025 (April 1, 2025 September 30, 2025)

During the six months ended September 30, 2025, the global economy continued to recover moderately, despite ongoing uncertainty caused by tariff policies and export controls in a number of countries.

In Japan, production in the manufacturing industry remained roughly flat, while capital expenditures were solid due to high corporate earnings. Overseas, the U.S. and Chinese economies slowed. The recovery of European economies decelerated in reaction to the end of last-minute production increases in anticipation of U.S tariff hikes. Asian economies outside China showed a moderate recovery, with varying paces across countries.

In this environment, total consolidated orders for the Kurita Group (the "Group") in the six months ended September 30, 2025 fell 2.6% from the level of the year-ago period, to 206,788 million yen, and net sales increased 1.4%, to 198,296 million yen. Business profit* increased 11.1%, to 23,584 million yen, operating profit was 24,900 million yen, up 15.9% versus the year-ago period, profit before tax was 24,564 million yen, rising 14.8%, and profit attributable to owners of parent amounted to 17,174 million yen, up 15.0%.

2) Segment Information

The Group has Electronics Industry and General Industry as two reportable segments in its segment information in order to formulate strategies based on an in-depth examination of the characteristics of each market and to expand solutions by combining diverse products and services, from the viewpoint of providing value to society and customers.

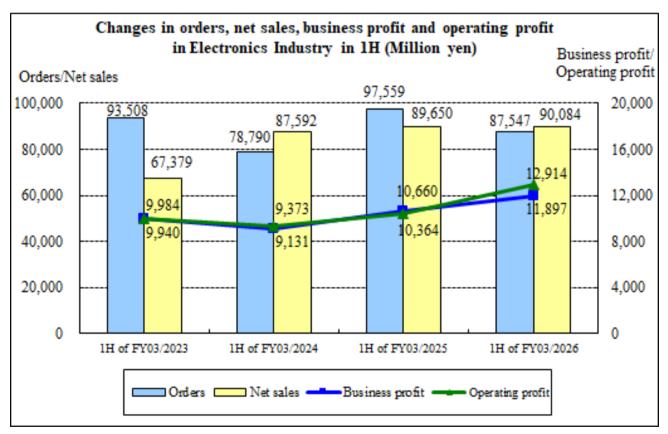
Due to a reorganization that occurred in the fiscal year under review, Arcade Engineering GmbH and certain divisions of Kurita America Inc. (water treatment facilities business), which were previously classified into the General Industry segment, have been moved to the Electronics Industry segment. The figures for the same period of the previous fiscal year have been adjusted to reflect the changes in the reportable segments.

(i) Electronics Industry

Total Group orders for the Electronics Industry segment were 87,547 million yen, down 10.3% versus the year-ago period. Orders for water treatment facilities fell due to the lack of an order for a large-scale project in the same period of the previous fiscal year. The demand for precision tool cleaning declined due to a fall in capacity utilization at plants of certain customers. Orders for recurring contract-based services, including the ultrapure water supply business, and maintenance rose.

Total Group net sales for the Electronics Industry segment amounted to 90,084 million yen, an increase of 0.5% year on year. Net sales of water treatment facilities declined due to the lack of sales from large-scale projects in China recorded in the same period of the previous fiscal year. Net sales from maintenance services increased due to sales from a backlog of orders. Net sales of recurring contract-based services increased, mainly reflecting ultrapure water supply contracts, which began in the previous fiscal year. Net sales from precision tool cleaning dropped.

In terms of profits, business profit stood at 11,897 million yen, an increase of 11.6% year on year, driven by higher sales from recurring contract-based services and maintenance, which have relatively strong profitability, and improved profitability for water treatment facilities. Operating profit came to 12,914 million yen, an increase of 24.6% year on year, reflecting settlement gains from the midterm termination of ultrapure water supply contracts with a certain customer.

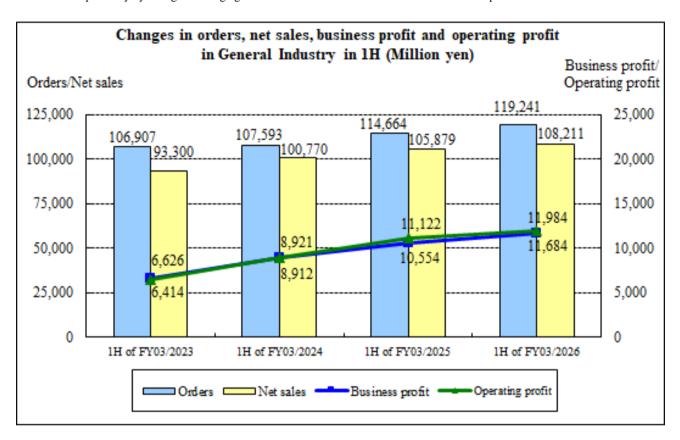


(ii) General Industry

Total Group orders for the General Industry segment increased 4.0% from the previous fiscal year, to 119,241 million yen. Orders for water treatment chemicals remained flat, reflecting the stronger yen, particularly against the U.S. dollar, which had a negative effect when orders were converted to yen, and a decline in demand in Southeast Asian markets. However, there was a significant increase in orders for soil remediation services due to a large project. Orders for water treatment facilities, maintenance, and recurring contract-based services also increased.

Total Group net sales for the General Industry segment amounted to 108,211 million yen, an increase of 2.2% year on year. Net sales for water treatment facilities rose due to progress on large projects. Net sales for maintenance and recurring contract-based services also increased. However, net sales for water treatment chemicals declined due to weak market conditions in certain countries and regions, as well as the stronger yen, which negatively impacted sales when converted to yen.

In terms of profits, business profit stood at 11,684 million yen, an increase of 10.7% year on year, reflecting higher net sales for the CSV business with high added value. Operating profit totaled 11,984 million yen, up 7.8% year on year. This increase was driven primarily by foreign exchange gains from subsidiaries in the United States and Europe.



(2) Financial Condition

Condition of Assets, Liabilities and Equity

1) Total assets: 553,931 million yen, an increase of 4,982 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year)

Current assets totaled 224,958 million yen at the end of the interim period, an increase of 4,008 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This is mainly due to an increase of 2,262 million yen in cash and cash equivalents and an increase of 1,507 million yen in trade and other receivables.

Non-current assets totaled 328,972 million yen at the end of the interim period, an increase of 974 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was chiefly attributable to an increase of 1,556 million yen in goodwill, when converted to yen, due to the weakening of the yen against foreign currencies, and an increase of 1,421 million yen in other financial assets. These increases outweighed a 2,319 million yen decrease in deferred tax assets.

- 2) Liabilities: 215,218 million yen, an increase of 4,774 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year

 Current liabilities totaled 129,352 million yen at the end of the interim period, a decrease of 3,215 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This is chiefly attributable to decreases of 5,460 million yen in trade and other payables and 1,672 million yen in other current liabilities, which offset an increase of 3,378 million yen in bonds and borrowings.
 - Non-current liabilities totaled 85,866 million yen at the end of the interim period, an increase of 7,989 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. This was mainly due to an increase of 8,815 million yen in bonds and borrowings, primarily because of the issuance of new bonds (totaling 10,000 million yen), which more than offset a decrease of 825 million yen in deferred tax liabilities.
- 3) Equity: 338,712 million yen, an increase of 208 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year

 The increase in equity was primarily attributable to an increase of 3,199 million yen in other components of equity, mainly due to larger exchange differences on translation of foreign operations, reflecting the weakening of the yen against other currencies,

and a rise of 12,019 million yen in retained earnings, primarily due to the posting of a profit attributable to owners of parent, which outweighed a decrease in equity caused by an increase of 14,924 million yen in treasury shares that followed purchases made in the market.

(3) Cash Flows

Consolidated cash and cash equivalents at the end of the interim period totaled 65,214 million yen, an increase of 2,262 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year.

The various cash flows and related factors are outlined below.

1) Cash Flows from Operating Activities

Net cash provided by operating activities during the six months ended September 30, 2025 totaled 28,326 million yen, a decrease of 12,285 million yen from the same period of the previous fiscal year. This was chiefly due to inflows, including profit before tax of 24,564 million yen and depreciation expense, amortization, and impairment losses of 17,345 million yen, partially offset by outflows that included an increase in trade and other receivables of 1,033 million yen, a decrease in trade and other payables of 1,680 million yen, income taxes paid of 7,613 million yen, and other (primarily a decrease in other current liabilities) of 2,211 million yen.

2) Cash Flows from Investing Activities

Net cash used in investing activities totaled 17,006 million yen, a decrease of 10,672 million yen from the same period of the previous fiscal year. Cash was used mainly for purchase of property, plant and equipment of 14,482 million yen and purchase of intangible assets of 2,115 million yen.

3) Cash Flows from Financing Activities

Net cash used in financing activities totaled 10,917 million yen, a decrease of 3,412 million yen from the same period of the previous fiscal year. Cash was used mainly for the purchase of treasury shares of 15,161 million yen, dividends paid of 5,207 million yen, and repayments of lease liabilities of 2,682 million yen, which were partially offset by proceeds from issuance of bonds of 9,954 million yen and a net increase in short-term borrowings and commercial paper of 3,315 million yen.

The Group's basic policy is to constantly secure the liquidity necessary for business operations and establish a stable fundraising system. Short-term working capital, capital investment and other investments in growth fields depend chiefly on the Group's own funds, but the Group procures financing through bond markets and bank loans as needed. As of the end of the period under review, the Group has concluded commitment line contracts with two financial institutions (no borrowing executed and unexecuted borrowings within the commitment line was 20,000 million yen).

(4) Forecasts for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 2026

The Group considers that consolidated earnings forecasts for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 will be consistent with the forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 in the "Consolidated Financial Results for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2025" released on May 8, 2025.

The business forecasts are made by the Company based on information available at the time of publication of this report and may differ from actual results due to changes in a range of factors.

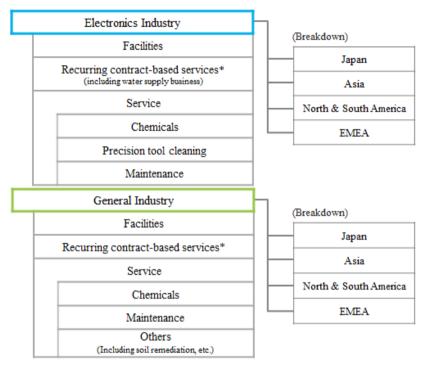
