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Notice Concerning Changes in Representative Director and Governance Structure

EIZO Corporation (“EIZO”) hereby announces that it has resolved, at a meeting of the Board of Directors held March 12, 2026, to make a preliminary decision on changes in its Directors, including a change in the Representative Director, as outlined below.

The change in the Representative Director and other Directors, as well as their selection, has been made based on the recommendation by the Nomination and Compensation Advisory Committee.

Through this review of the executive structure, EIZO aims to further enhance the transparency and objectivity of management decision-making and supervisory functions by increasing the ratio of External Directors on the Board.

In addition, by increasing the number of female Directors from one to two and forming a Board composition that emphasizes diversity, EIZO seeks to further enhance the overall effectiveness of the Board and strengthen its corporate governance framework.

4. New Governance Structure of the Audit and Supervisory Committee


In conjunction with the changes to the Audit and Supervisory Committee, EIZO will transition to a governance structure that does not include a full-time Audit and Supervisory Committee member. Instead, an Operating Officer in charge of the Audit and Supervisory Committee Secretariat will, under the direction and supervision of the Audit and Supervisory Committee, be responsible for supporting the Committee's operations, collecting information, and coordinating with relevant departments.

The Operating Officer will also oversee the internal audit department and will report under a dual-reporting line to both the Audit and Supervisory Committee and the Representative Director.

There will be no change to the authority or responsibilities of the Audit and Supervisory Committee as a result of this change.

Following the implementation of this change, the Audit and Supervisory Committee will continue to appropriately fulfill its duties, by auditing the legality and appropriateness of Directors' execution of duties and by cooperating with the Internal Audit Department and the Accounting Auditor.
