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Notice Concerning Additional Acquisition of Shares in an Equity-Method Affiliate (to Make It a Consolidated Subsidiary)

ANRITSU CORPORATION (the "Company") announces that, at a meeting of its Board of Directors held today, it resolved to enter into a share transfer agreement to acquire an additional 18.28% of the issued shares of SmartViser SAS (headquartered in Rennes, France; "SmartViser"), in which the Company currently holds a 32.72% share, for the purpose of making SmartViser a consolidated subsidiary of the Company.

As this acquisition does not meet the criteria set forth in the Timely Disclosure Rules, certain disclosure items and details have been omitted.

1. Purpose of the Share Acquisition

SmartViser provides automated testing solutions to mobile network operators, device manufacturers, and others. Its business includes performance evaluation of mobile networks and devices, functional testing, quality monitoring, and compliance with EU smartphone energy labelling regulations ((EEI — Energy Efficiency Index). In March 2025, the Company acquired a 32.72% share in SmartViser and has since engaged in collaboration with SmartViser while maintaining each company's operational independence.

By making SmartViser a consolidated subsidiary, the Company will be able to combine SmartViser's expertise in test automation and efficiency-related technologies with the Company's advanced test solutions in the telecommunications field. This is expected to expand business opportunities not only in the smartphone market, but also across a wide range of industries utilizing communications technologies, including private networks, mission-critical networks, and the automotive sector. Through this initiative, the Company aims to contribute to the realization of a carbon-neutral and smart society.
