## Notice of Differences Between the Consolidated Financial Results for the Year Ended March 20, 2026 and the Consolidated Financial Results for the Previous Fiscal Year

The Company hereby announces the differences between the consolidated financial results for the year ended March 20, 2026 (hereinafter, “consolidated financial results for the current fiscal year”) and the consolidated financial results for the year ended March 20, 2025 (hereinafter, “consolidated financial results for the previous fiscal year”). As the Company has not disclosed its consolidated earnings forecasts for the year ended March 20, 2026 it hereby provides an explanation of the differences between the consolidated financial results for the current fiscal year and the consolidated financial results for the previous fiscal year. The details are as follows.

1. Differences between the consolidated financial results for the current fiscal year and the consolidated financial results for the previous fiscal year

2. Reason for differences

Net sales, operating income, ordinary income, and net income attributable to owners of parent for the current fiscal year all increased year on year, mainly due to the contribution of sales of new products and the strengthening of the sales structure.
