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#### Consolidated Operating Results

#### (1) Overview of Consolidated Operating Results

The Group has set forth the vision of becoming "the world's most exciting medical and healthcare company." Following the hospice (Ishinkan) business, the Group aims to establish its second and third pillars of business and to become a company that will continue to prosper for the next 100 years.

During the current fiscal year, the Group opened 29 new facilities under the *Ishinkan* business (Iwate: 1, Ibaraki: 1, Saitama: 2, Chiba: 1, Tokyo: 5, Kanagawa: 1, Niigata: 1, Toyama: 1, Ishikawa: 1, Gifu: 1, Shizuoka: 1, Aichi: 2, Mie: 1, Hyogo: 3, Tottori: 1, Hiroshima: 1, Kagawa: 1, Ehime: 1, Fukuoka: 1, Oita: 1, Miyazaki: 1), and expanded one existing facility (Shizuoka: 1). Meanwhile, the Group closed one facility (*Ishinkan Hongo*) and transferred the operations of *Ishinkan Himeji* to another operator. Going forward, the Group will continue to implement detailed marketing and development strategies to proactively open new facilities, while also engaging in vigorous sales activities targeting medical institutions and others. Through these initiatives, the Group aims to achieve long-term and sustainable growth.

In recent years, the Group has leveraged the expertise and know-how accumulated through the operation of *Ishinkan* facilities and has fully entered the comprehensive medical support business. During the current consolidated fiscal year, the Group steadily built a track record of providing management support services to medical institutions.

Going forward, the Group will expand its initiatives beyond local and depopulated areas to provide comprehensive management support to a wide range of medical institutions, including general hospitals and community-based hospitals.

The Group will continue to be a hungry challenger, boldly questioning conventional practices and exploring innovative solutions to create essential and fundamental value, while envisioning an ambitious future.

As a result, the operating results for the current consolidated fiscal year are as follows.

#### (2) Overview of Financial Position

#### (Assets)

Total assets as of September 30, 2025 were 83,947 million yen, an increase of 12,148 million yen from September 30, 2024. This is attributable mainly to increases of 1,964 million yen in cash and deposits due to higher borrowings, and 8,421 million yen in property, plant and equipment and 349 million yen in leasehold and guarantee deposits in line with opening new facilities.

#### (Liabilities)

Total liabilities as of September 30, 2025 were 47,814 million yen, an increase of 9,227 million yen from September 30, 2024. This is attributable mainly to increases of 7,360 million yen in borrowings and 1,043 million yen in lease obligations in line with opening new facilities, 1,039 million yen in accounts payable - other and accrued expenses due to the business expansion.

#### (Net assets)

Net assets as of September 30, 2025 amounted to 36,132 million yen, an increase of 2,920 million yen from September 30, 2024. This increase was mainly due to a rise of 3,660 million yen in profit attributable to owners of parent and a decrease of 391 million

yen due to the payment of dividends, resulting in a net increase of 3,268 million yen in retained earnings. In addition, the acquisition of treasury shares caused an increase of 278 million yen in treasury shares, which was a factor decreasing net assets.

## (3) Overview of Cash Flows

Cash and cash equivalents as of September 30, 2025 stood at 10,833 million yen, an increase of 1,964 million yen from September 30, 2024. Cash flows for the period and the factors contributing to increases or decreases in cash flows are described below.

#### (Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash provided by operating activities for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2025 was 6,025 million yen, versus 7,484 million yen for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2024. This is attributable mainly to profit before income taxes of 5,685 million yen, depreciation of 2,753 million yen, despite income taxes paid of 3,528 million yen, and an increase in accounts receivable of 731 million yen.

#### (Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used in investing activities for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2025 was 10,427 million yen, versus 16,828 million yen for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2024. This reflected mainly purchase of property, plant and equipment of 10,407 million yen and payments of leasehold and guarantee deposits of 443 million yen in conjunction with the opening of new facilities.

#### (Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash provided by financing activities for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2025 was 6,365 million yen, versus 6,083 million yen for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2024. This is attributable mainly to proceeds from short-term borrowings of 4,366 million yen in conjunction with the opening of new facilities and net increase in long-term borrowings of 7,613 million yen, despite repayments of long-term borrowings of 4,639 million yen.

#### (4) Forecast

The Group's policy is to pursue long-term and sustainable growth by steadily expanding the *Ishinkan* business through the opening of new facilities based on detailed marketing and development strategies, while also conducting vigorous sales activities targeting medical institutions and other related organizations. In the next fiscal year, the Group plans to open nine new facilities, bringing the total number of facilities to 139 (7,232 beds) as of the end of September 2026. In addition to contributions from newly opened facilities, the Group expects a moderate recovery in occupancy rates at existing facilities. However, taking into account uncertainties such as the impact of the revision of medical service fees scheduled for FY2026 and the increase in personnel and other expenses, the Group has formulated its plan on a conservative basis. Furthermore, the Group will continue to strengthen its initiatives in the comprehensive medical support business, including collaboration with medical institutions and community-based efforts to address social issues such as regional disparities in medical access. The Group has decided to emphasize EBITDA as a key performance indicator, aiming to eliminate accounting distortions and focus on the returns from strategic investments.

Based on these premises, the Group forecasts net sales of 51,700 million yen, EBITDA of 7,100 million yen, operating profit of 3,800 million yen, ordinary profit of 3,300 million yen, and profit attributable to owners of parent of 2,100 million yen for the next fiscal year. The above forecasts are based on information available at the time of publication and are subject to uncertainties. However, actual results may differ materially from these forecasts due to changes in business conditions and other factors.

#### 2. Basic Concept Regarding the Selection of Accounting Standards

To facilitate comparison with other companies in the same industry in Japan, the Group employs Japanese GAAP as its accounting standard.

The Accounting Standard for Corporate, Inhabitant and Enterprise Taxes (ASBJ Statement No. 27, issued on October 28, 2022; hereinafter referred to as the "Revised Accounting Standard 2022") and other related standards have been applied from the beginning of the fiscal year ended September 30, 2025.

The amendment to the categories in which current income taxes should be recorded (taxes on other comprehensive income) follows the transitional treatment prescribed in paragraph 20-3 of the Revised Accounting Standard 2022 and paragraph 65-2 of the Revised Implementation Guidance on Tax Effect Accounting (ASBJ Guidance No. 28, issued on October 28, 2022). This change in accounting policies has no material impact on the consolidated financial statements for the fiscal year.

With respect to the amendment related to the revised accounting treatment for consolidated financial statements when gains or losses on the sale of shares in subsidiaries arising from intra-group transactions were deferred for tax purposes, the Revised Implementation Guidance 2022 has been applied from the beginning of the fiscal year ended September 30, 2025. This change in accounting policies was applied retrospectively, and accordingly, the consolidated financial statements for the previous fiscal year have been restated.
