*Explanation of the appropriate use of earnings forecasts and other special notes

The forward-looking statements in this document, including earnings forecasts, are based on information currently available to the Company and certain assumptions that the Company believes to be reasonable. Actual results may differ materially from these statements due to a variety of factors. Refer to page 3, "1. 1. Qualitative Information on Quarterly Results

(1) Explanation of Business Results

During the first half of the consolidated accounting period, During the second quarter of the fiscal year ending March 2026, the global economic outlook remained uncertain due to changes in U.S. foreign policy and trade/tariff policies, as well as heightened tensions between the United States and China.

Concerns about an economic slowdown in the U.S. are intensifying. In China, the effects of economic stimulus measures have been limited, and amid persistently low inflation, the economic recovery has slowed slightly. The European economy showed variation by country and region but maintained positive growth overall. For Japan's economy, concerns exist regarding sluggish exports due to U.S. tariff policies and a decline in housing investment.

As for the consolidated business results of V Technology group (herein after "the group" or "the company") for the first half of the current fiscal year, net sales amounted to 19,744 million yen (22,345 million in same period last year, hereinafter figures in brackets() refer to the same period of the previous year), and operating loss amounted to 370 million yen (operating loss 136 million), Ordinary loss was 406 million(ordinary loss 275 million yen), Net loss attributable to owners of the parent amounted to 239 million(net loss of 218 million yen).

Orders received by the Group in the first half of the recent consolidated fiscal year totaled 17,351 million yen(17,561 million yen). As a result, the order backlog at the first half of the recent consolidated fiscal year under review amounted to 41,271 million yen (32,316 million yen).

Segment results are as follows.

(FPD Equipment Business)

In the FPD equipment business, capital expenditures related to flat panel displays generally progressed as planned, with some exceptions.

Under these circumstances, orders received in the Group's FPD equipment business during the current first quater of the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 totaled 9,304million yen (10,484 million yen in the same period of the previous year), with an order backlog of 24,216 million yen (14,147 million yen in the same period of the previous year), net sales amounted to 9,895 million yen (16,237 million yen in the same period of the previous year), and operating loss was 309 million yen (operating profit 107 million yen in the same period of the previous year).

(Semiconductor and Photomask Equipment Business)

In the semiconductor and photomask equipment business, there were no major changes in related capital investments, and operations proceeded largely as planned.

Under these circumstances, orders received by the Group in the semiconductor and photomask equipment business during the current first quarter of the fiscal year ending march 31 2026 totaled 7,346 million yen (6,374 million yen in the same period of the previous year), and the order backlog totaled 17,055 million yen (18,168 million yen in the same period of the previous year), net sales amounted to 9,148 million yen (5,406 million yen in the same period of the previous year), and operating profit was 46 million yen (operating loss 74 million yen in the same period of the previous year).

(2) Explanation of Financial Condition

#1 Condition of Assets, Liabilities & Net assets

(Assets)

Total assets at the end of the first half of the current fiscal year decreased by 1,532 million yen from the end of the last last fiscal year to 71,668 million yen. This was mainly due to a decrease in "Cash and deposits" of 6,719 million yen, and an increase in "Work in progress" of 2,838, "Notes and accounts receivable" of 1,811 million yen.

(Liabilities)

Total liabilities at the end of the first half of the current fiscal year year increased by 1,209 million yen from the end of the last last fiscal year to 38,409 million yen. This was mainly due to a decrease of 2,087 million yen in "Long-term borrowings", and an increases of 854 million yen in "Advance payment ".

(Net assets

Net assets decreased by 323 million yen from the end of the last fiscal year to 33,258 million yen. This was mainly due to a decrease of 624 million yen in "Retained earnings" and an increase of 213 million yen in "Foreign currency translation adjustment"

#2 Condition of Cash flows

Cash and cash equivalents ('funds') at the end of the first half of financial year increased by 6,743 million compared to the same period of the previous financial year, to 19,381 million. The status of each cash flow is as follows.

(Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash used by operating activities was 3,734 million yen (compared to 3,033 million yen provided in the same period of the previous year). The main factors contributing to the cash outflow were an increase in "Inventory" of 2,606 million yen and an increase in "Trade receivables" of 1,651 million yen. The main factor contributing to the cash inflow was an increase in "Advance payment" of 843 million yen.

(Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used in investing activities was 702 million yen (versus 747 million yen used the previous period). The main use of funds was 819 million yen in expenditure associated with the acquisition of "Tangible fixed assets".

(Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash used by financing activities was 2,337 million yen (versus 3,444 million yen provided the previous period). The main use of funds was 2,505 million jpy in a net decrease of "long-term borrowings".

(3) Explanation of Forward-Looking Statements

There is no change to the consolidated earnings forecast for the fiscal year ending March 2026 as stated in the "Summary of Financial Results for the Fiscal Year Ended March 2025" announced on May 13, 2025.
