Regarding the Release of Nintendo Switch 2

Nintendo Co., Ltd. (HQ: Kyoto, Japan, President and Representative Director: Shuntaro Furukawa; hereinafter “Nintendo”) hereby announces that it has decided today to release the new game system, Nintendo Switch 2 (hereinafter “the product”) as below.

1. About the product

Nintendo Switch 2 is the successor to Nintendo Switch. It has a larger screen, new Joy-Con controllers with magnetic connectors, powerful processing speed, and graphical performance which enables new gameplay.

Nintendo Switch 2 Japanese-Language System (Japan Only) will be released on June 5, 2025 at a manufacturer’s suggested retail price of 49,980 yen (including tax). 2. Impact of the product on consolidated net sales

The projected impact of the product on Nintendo’s consolidated sales has not yet been determined. Nintendo plans to disclose the consolidated financial forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026, at the time of our financial results announcement for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2025 (scheduled for May 8, 2025). In the aforementioned announcement, Nintendo will disclose the consolidated sales forecast for this fiscal year, which will include the impact of sales of the product.

3. Expenses specifically incurred to commercialize the product

Of the expenditures related to the product, it is difficult to reasonably identify the expenses specifically incurred for the launch of the product, as distinct from expenses related to other Nintendo products.

4. Future Business Projection

The consolidated financial forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 is scheduled to be disclosed at the financial results announcement for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2025 (scheduled for May 8, 2025). The financial forecast for subsequent fiscal years has not been determined as of now, but Nintendo will make prompt announcements when matters to be disclosed in accordance with the rules of the Tokyo Stock Exchange, Inc. arise.
