## Notice Concerning Establishment of a Subsidiary

SHOFU INC. (“the Company”) hereby announces that it established a subsidiary on April 1, 2026 as follows.

### 1. Purpose of Establishment

The Company has undertaken market research and information gathering in the Middle East and Africa region through its Middle East and Africa Representative Office established in April 2021, while also supporting Group companies responsible for sales in the region. In addition to expanding our market presence in the Middle East and North Africa, and with a view to launching full-scale operations in Sub-Saharan Africa (i.e the African market excluding Mediterranean coastal countries), where further growth is anticipated, the Company has decided to establish the Middle East and Africa Representative Office as a locally incorporated subsidiary to strengthen its business operations.
