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## 1. Qualitative Information on Consolidated Results for the Three months Ended June 30, 2025

## (1) Details of consolidated results

During the first three months under review (from April 1, 2025 to June 30, 2025), the outlook for the global economy remained uncertain. This was primarily attributable to the uncertainty over U.S. tariff policy, prolonged economic stagnation in China, and growing geopolitical risks stemming from the deteriorating situation in the Middle East.

In the U.S., the inflation resulting from tariff hikes increased the risk of putting downward pressure on personal consumption and capital expenditures. This raised concerns about a potential economic downturn.

In Europe, although personal consumption remained firm, the risks of downward pressure on the economy were on the rise, due to political situation in major countries and decline in exports to the U.S. resulting from planned U.S. tariff hikes.

In China, while recent personal consumption demonstrated a moderate recovery due to policy effects, the economy remained sluggish due to the ongoing real estate slump and other factors. This raised concerns that a full economic recovery would take some time.

The Japanese economy experienced a moderate recovery as personal consumption remained firm against the backdrop of an improved income environment and other factors. However, there were concerns that interest rate and the direct and indirect impacts of U.S. tariff hikes would weigh on the economic recovery .

Revenue increased, primary by strong performance in the ICT solution business and the mobile business. On the other hand, profit declined primarily due to underperformance in the meat products business.

As a result, consolidated revenue increased by \$105 million (0.0%) year on year, to \$251,116 million. Consolidated gross profit also increased by \$3,585 million (10.0%) from a year earlier, to \$39,296 million. Consolidated operating profit decreased by \$1,130 million (9.6%) from a year earlier, to \$10,640 million. Profit before tax decreased by \$790 million (6.9%) year on year, to \$10,645 million. Profit attributable to owners of the parent decreased by \$476 million (6.4%) year on year, to \$6,984 million.

Results for each business segment are described below.

## (i) ICT Solution

Revenue increased by ¥3,973 million year on year, to ¥20,712 million, due to strong performance in projects for network and system construction for the manufacturing and distribution industries. Operating profit increased by ¥902 million, to ¥2,312 million, and profit attributable to owners of the parent increased by ¥569 million, to ¥1,517 million.

## (ii) Electronics & Devices

Revenue increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4}\),683 million year on year, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{5}\),601 million, attributable to higher revenue in the mobile business and the semiconductor parts and manufacturing equipment business. Operating profit increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1}\),057 million, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3}\),842 million, mainly driven by growth in the mobile business. Profit attributable to owners of the parent increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{7}}{7}\)7 million, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}\),697 million.

## (iii) Foods, Meat & Grain

Revenue increased by \$6,977 million year on year, to \$94,628 million, reflecting higher revenue in the grain, oilseeds & feedstuff business and the foods business. Operating profit decreased by \$2,035 million, to \$1,668 million, primarily due to the reduced profitability in the grain, oilseeds & feedstuff business and the meat products business. Profit attributable to owners of the parent decreased by \$1,098 million, to \$958 million.

# (iv) Steel, Materials & Plant

Revenue decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{9},631\) million year on year, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4}0,156\) million, due to a downturn in the steel and steel tubing business and the energy business. Operating profit decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{5}80\) million, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1},556\) million, impacted by weaker performance in the plant business and the environment-related business. Profit attributable to owners of the parent decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}26\) million, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1},082\) million.

Revenue decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{27}\) million year on year, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{489}\) million, while the operating loss increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{8}}{87}\) million, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{103}\) million, and the profit attributable to owners of the parent increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{9}\) million, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{103}\) million.

## (2) Details of financial position

# (i) Assets, liabilities and equity

Total assets at the end of June 30, 2025, decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{449}}{49}\),060 million from the end of the previous fiscal year, to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4640}}{40}\),277 million.

Interest-bearing debt decreased by ¥5,723 million from the end of the previous fiscal year, to ¥173,178 million. Net interest-bearing debt after deducting cash and deposits increased by ¥1,368 million from the end of the previous fiscal year, to ¥121,704 million. Interest-bearing debt does not include lease liabilities.

In terms of equity, equity attributable to owners of the parent increased by ¥4,236 million from the end of the previous fiscal year, to ¥178,178 million, mainly due to the accumulation of profit attributable to owners of the parent.

As a result, the equity ratio attributable to owners of the parent was 27.8%. The net debt-to-equity ratio was 0.68 times.

## (ii) Cash flows

Cash and cash equivalents at the end of June 30, 2025, decreased by \$7,563 million from the end of the previous fiscal year, to \$49,216 million.

# (Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash provided by operating activities for the three months ended June 30, 2025, was \(\frac{\pmathbf{X}}{7}\),433 million (\(\frac{\pmathbf{X}}{8}\),228 million in the same period of the previous fiscal year), mainly reflecting the accumulation of operating revenue and a decline in working capital.

# (Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used in investing activities for the three months ended June 30, 2025, was \(\pm\)1,937 million (\(\pm\)2,555 million used in the same period of the previous fiscal year), mainly reflecting payments for the execution of business investments such as the acquisition of property, plant and equipment, as well as subsidiaries.

# (Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash used in financing activities for the three months ended June 30, 2025 was \(\frac{\text{\$\text{\$4}}}{14,266}\) million (\(\frac{\text{\$\text{\$\text{\$\text{\$\text{\$}}}}}{553}\) million used in the same period of the previous fiscal year), mainly due to repayments of borrowings and lease liabilities, as well as dividend payments.

# (Segment information)

#### (1) Summary of reportable segments

The Group's reportable segments are components of the Group for which separate financial information is available, and which are regularly used by the Board of Directors when allocating management resources and evaluating performance, and they are subject to regular consideration.

The Group provides a variety of products and services by organically integrating its expertise cultivated through its internal and external network in each business sector and trading company functions such as business transactions, information collection, market development, business development and formation, risk management, and logistics.

Moreover, the Group consists of business segments by product and service based on the sales department and it has set the five segments, "ICT Solution," "Electronics & Devices," "Foods, Meat & Grain," "Steel, Materials & Plant," and "Motor Vehicles & Aerospace," as its reportable segments.

# (2) Information on reportable segments

The accounting treatment for the reported business segments is the same as the accounting policies applied to the consolidated financial statements for the previous fiscal year.

Inter-segment revenue and transfers are determined according to transaction prices with outside customers.
