During the fiscal year under review, the Japanese economy saw solid corporate performance and stock prices performed well, but the yen remained weak due to the Bank of Japan's cautious stance on interest rate hikes, and prices remained high, particularly for imported goods. In the food industry, price hikes continued, and amid budget-minded spending patterns of consumers, efforts to strengthen product competitiveness continued. Under these circumstances, the ShoEi Foods Corporation Group leveraged its strengths as both a trading company and a company with a manufacturing division, and sought to supply value-added products through initiatives such as strengthening cooperation with overseas suppliers and developing products tailored to customer needs.

As a result of these efforts, consolidated net sales for the fiscal year under review increased by 8.4% year on year to 124,897 million yen, thanks to increases in sales across all segments—Japan, the United States, and China.

On the profit front, operating profit increased by 2.0% year on year to 4,942 million yen, and ordinary profit increased by 0.8% to 4,992 million yen. This was owing to an increase in gross profit resulting from price optimization by reflecting increases in raw ingredients costs despite an increase in selling, general and administrative expenses resulting from costs for digital transformation and increases in personnel expenses. Profit attributable to owners of parent decreased 4.2% year on year to 3,035 million yen due to 144 million yen of advisory fees for core system renewal recorded in software in progress in the previous fiscal year being recorded as extraordinary losses based on a review of development requirements, in addition to 290 million yen for the compensation for damage as a result of labor litigation at affiliates in the United States and at others, recorded in the first quarter of the fiscal year.

Business results by region for the fiscal year under review are as follows.

1) Japan

In Japan, net sales increased by 6.2% year on year to 109,128 million yen due to the progress of hikes in sales prices in response to rising raw ingredient costs and the increased sales of major products, including imported dairy products, nuts, dried fruits, and confectionery and retail products.

Segment profit increased by 3.6% year on year to 4,602 million yen owing to an increase in gross profit as a result of the progress of price hikes and improved factory operating ratio despite an increase in selling, general and administrative expenses resulting from an increase in costs related to digital transformation, mainly advisory fees for core system renewal.

2) United States

In the United States, net sales increased by 11.6% year on year to 9,984 million yen due to price hikes reflecting higher market prices despite decreased volumes received and sold of both walnuts and prunes, the mainstay products, due to crop conditions.

Segment profit increased by 23.8% year on year to 470 million yen. For walnuts, although profit margins improved for shelled sales, profits decreased due to the impact of decreased sales volume. On the other hand, prunes saw higher profits due to increased sales in Japan and higher prices.

3) China

In China, net sales increased by 10.9% year on year to 11,681 million yen due to the increased sales of nuts in China, mainly almonds, despite the decreased exports of Chinese-grown seeds and dried fruits.

Segment profit decreased by 28.3% year on year to 321 million yen owing to temporary costs for efforts to improve profitability such as changes of logistics and roles of offices, despite an increase in gross profit due to higher sales in China.

(2) Overview of Financial Position for the Fiscal Year under Review (Assets, liabilities, and net assets)

Total assets as of October 31, 2025 amounted to 96,586 million yen, an increase of 6,680 million yen compared with the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to increases of 310 million yen in cash and deposits, 1,930 million yen in notes and accounts receivable - trade, 3,494 million yen in merchandise and finished goods, 466 million yen in work in process, and 916 million yen in raw ingredients and supplies, despite a decrease of 422 million yen in advance payments to suppliers, resulting in current assets of 65,764 million yen (68.0% of total assets), an increase of 6,616 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. Non-current assets increased by 64 million yen compared with the end of the previous fiscal year to 30,822 million yen (31.9% of total assets) due to an increase of 850 million yen in investments and other assets, despite decreases of 645 million yen in property, plant and equipment and 140 million yen in intangible assets.

Total liabilities as of October 31, 2025 amounted to 40,655 million yen (42.0% of total assets), an increase of 4,919 million yen compared with the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to increases of 5,202 million yen in short-term borrowings, 2,467 million yen in current portion of long-term borrowings, 483 million yen in accounts payable - other, 207 million yen in income taxes payable, and 116 million yen in provision for bonuses, despite a decrease of 915 million yen in notes and accounts payable - trade, resulting in current liabilities of 33,770 million yen (34.9% of total assets), an increase of 7,981 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year. Non-current liabilities decreased by 3,062 million yen compared with the end of previous fiscal year to 6,884 million yen (7.1% of total assets) due to decreases of 2,837 million yen in long-term borrowings and 177 million yen in deferred tax liabilities.

Total net assets as of October 31, 2025 amounted to 55,931 million yen (57.9% of total assets), an increase of 1,761 million yen compared with the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to increases of 2,109 million yen in retained earnings, 539 million yen in foreign currency translation adjustment,

and 103 million yen in non-controlling interests, despite an increase of 1,102 million yen in treasury shares.

(3) Overview of Cash Flows for the Fiscal Year under Review

Cash and cash equivalents (hereinafter referred to as "cash") at the end of the fiscal year under review amounted to 11,505 million yen, an increase of 310 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year.

The status of cash flows and contributing factors for the fiscal year under review are as follows.

(Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash used in operating activities amounted to 610 million yen (net cash provided of 3,085 million yen in the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly attributable to profit before income taxes of 4,520 million yen, depreciation of 2,831 million yen, impairment losses of 144 million yen, compensation for damage of 290 million yen, interest and dividend income of 131 million yen, interest expenses of 238 million yen, an increase in trade receivables of 1,829 million yen, an increase in inventories of 4,769 million yen, a decrease in trade payables of 980 million yen, interest and dividends received of 149 million yen, interest paid of 239 million yen, and income taxes paid of 1,493 million yen.

The main factors behind the year-on-year increase in net cash used were decreases in profit before income taxes of 437 million yen and trade payables of 2,950 million yen, and increases in trade receivables of 963 million yen and inventories of 956 million yen, despite increases in impairment losses of 144 million yen and compensation for damage of 290 million yen.

(Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used in investing activities amounted to 1,856 million yen (a decrease of 769 million yen year on year). This was mainly attributable to purchase of property, plant and equipment.

The main factors behind the year-on-year decrease in net cash used were decreases of 455 million yen in purchase of property, plant and equipment, and 293 million yen in purchase of intangible assets.

(Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash provided by financing activities amounted to 2,617 million yen (net cash used of 2,081 million yen in the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly attributable to a net increase in short-term borrowings of 5,174 million yen, repayments of long-term borrowings of 369 million yen, purchase of treasury shares of 1,123 million yen, repayments of lease liabilities of 126 million yen, and dividends paid of 926 million yen.

The main factors behind the year-on-year increase in net cash provided were a net increase in short-term borrowings of 5,962 million yen and a decrease in repayments of long-term borrowings of 2,001 million yen, despite a decrease in proceeds from long-term borrowings of 2,000 million yen and increases in purchase of treasury shares of 1,122 million yen and dividends paid of 101 million yen.

(4) Future Outlook

Although there are concerns about the impact of a slowdown in exports due to Trump tariffs, corporate performance remains strong, and capital investment is expected to recover, so the Japanese economy is expected to see positive growth. On the other hand, the impact of price increases due to the continued yen's depreciation is expected to continue, and the economic environment surrounding the Group is expected to remain uncertain. Under these circumstances, the Group will strive to ensure a stable supply of food raw ingredients by further promoting the diversification of suppliers and production areas, and it aims to achieve sustainable growth by leveraging its unique position as both a trading company and a manufacturer and by strengthening product planning capabilities.

For the fiscal year ending October 31, 2026, we expect consolidated net sales to be 130.0 billion yen, up 4.0% year on year. As for profits, we forecast an operating profit of 5,100 million yen (up 3.1% year on year), ordinary profit of 5,150 million yen (up 3.1% year on year), and profit attributable to owners of parent of 3,400 million yen (up 11.9% year on year).

2. Basic Policy on Selection of Accounting Standards

The Group prepares its consolidated financial statements in accordance with Japanese GAAP in order to ensure comparability of the consolidated financial statements from period to period and with other companies.

To provide for the payment of bonuses to employees, an amount accrued for the fiscal year under review among the estimated future payments is recorded.

c. Provision for bonuses for directors (and other officers)

To provide for the payment of bonuses to officers, an estimated amount of bonuses based on the estimated amount of payment is recorded.

d. Provision for retirement benefits for directors (and other officers)

Certain consolidated subsidiaries provide for the payment of retirement benefits to directors and officers based on the amount payable at the end of the fiscal year under review, in accordance with the rules for directors' and officers' retirement benefits (internal rules).

(4) Method of accounting for retirement benefits

a. Method of attributing estimated retirement benefits to periods

In calculating retirement benefit obligations, the estimated amount of retirement benefits is attributed to the period up to the end of the fiscal year under review based on the benefit calculation method.

b. Method of amortizing actuarial gains and losses

Actuarial gains and losses are amortized by the straight-line method over a fixed number of years (mainly 5 years) within the average remaining service period of employees at the time of occurrence in each consolidated fiscal year, with the amount prorated from the following consolidated fiscal year of occurrence.

c. Adoption of the simplified method for small companies

Some consolidated subsidiaries adopt the simplified method for the calculation of retirement benefit liability and retirement benefit expenses, using the amount payable at the end of the fiscal year due to voluntary termination as the retirement benefit obligations.

(5) Basis for recognition of significant revenues and expenses

The Group is engaged in the sale of raw ingredient dairy products, oils, and fats; confectionery ingredients; dried fruits and nuts; canned foods; and confectionery and retail products.

In the sale of products to domestic customers, performance obligations are deemed to have been satisfied at the time the products are inspected and accepted based on the sales contracts with the customers, and revenue is recognized at that point in time. However, given that the timeframe from the time of dispatch of the products to the time at which control of the products is transferred to the customer is within the normal timeframe, revenue from such products is recognized at the time of dispatch.

In the sale of products to overseas customers, performance obligations are deemed to have been satisfied at the time of shipment, and revenue is recognized at that point in time.

For transactions in which the promise with the customer is deemed to be a performance obligation to arrange for the provision of goods or services through another party, because the role of the Group is deemed to be an agent, the Group recognizes revenue on a net basis.

Regarding sell-buy transactions (transactions where the Company buys raw ingredients from a counterparty and sells back products made using the raw ingredients to the counterparty), the Group recognizes the net value of processing as revenue.

Additionally, revenue is recognized as the consideration promised in the contract with customers, less amounts such as rebates.

Considerations from transactions are received within one year from the recognition of revenue, and contain no significant financial components.

(6) Translation of significant assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies into yen

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Japanese yen at the spot exchange rates prevailing on the consolidated closing date, with translation differences recognized as gains or losses. Assets and liabilities, and revenues and expenses of overseas subsidiaries are translated into yen at the spot exchange rates in effect at the closing date of the overseas subsidiaries, and translation adjustments are included in foreign currency translation adjustment in net assets.

(7) Significant hedge accounting methods

a. Hedge accounting method

Deferred hedge accounting is applied. Allocation treatment is applied to foreign currency-denominated monetary receivables and payables with forward foreign exchange contracts, etc., and special treatment is applied to interest rate swaps that meet the conditions for special treatment.
