Notice regarding the postponement of the announcement of financial results for the first quarter of the fiscal year ending February 2026

AEON CO., LTD. (hereinafter, the company) hereby announces that it has decided to postpone the announcement of its first quarter financial results for the fiscal year ending February 2026, which was scheduled for July 11, 2025.

1. Reasons for postponement of first quarter financial results announcement

The company had been preparing to announce its financial results for the first quarter of the fiscal year ending February 2026 on July 11, 2025. However, following the June 6, 2025 announcement by its consolidated subsidiary, AEON Financial Service Co., Ltd. (“AFS”), regarding the discovery of inappropriate accounting practices at Post and Telecommunication Finance Company Limited (“PTF”) in Vietnam prior to the acquisition of equity, and in view of the ongoing discussions between AFS and Southeast Asia Commercial Joint Stock Bank (“SeABank”), the seller of the equity interest in PTF, as well as the time required to formulate a new growth strategy for its Vietnam operations, we have decided to postpone the announcement.

2. Future Schedule

The postponed announcement date for the first quarter financial results for the fiscal year ending February 2026 is now scheduled for July 31, 2025.

3. Impact on Business Performance

We are currently assessing the potential impact of this matter on our business performance for the fiscal year ending February 2026. Should any issues arise that require disclosure, we will make an announcement promptly.
