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Notice Concerning Unrealized Losses on Securities as of the End of the First Quarter of the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 2027

The Bank of Nagoya, Ltd. (the “Bank”) hereby announces that it has completed a calculation of the total amount of unrealized losses on securities (held-to-maturity debt securities) held by the Bank as of the end of the first quarter of the fiscal year ending March 31, 2027, as follows.

1. Securities subject to the calculation (held-to-maturity debt securities)

(A) Total amount of unrealized losses on securities as of the end of the first quarter of the fiscal year ending March 31, 2027	¥10,623 million
(B) Consolidated ordinary profit for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 (A/B × 100)	¥28,081 million (37.8%)
(C) Profit attributable to owners of parent for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 (A/C × 100)	¥20,269 million (52.4%)

(Notes) 1. Securities subject to the calculation are those held-to-maturity debt securities for which market value can be reasonably calculated.

2. Book value of the securities subject to the calculation	¥120,000 million
Market value	¥109,376 million
