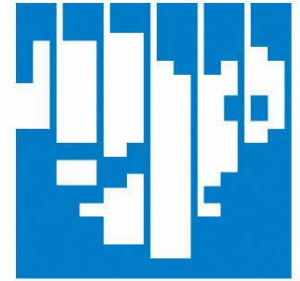

Overview of 2Q FY2025 Financial Results

<Senshu Ikeda Holdings, Inc. - Consolidated>

- **Profit attributable to owners of the parent** amounted to **8.6 bn yen**, up 0.2 bn yen year on year (up 1.5 bn yen from the forecast).

<The Senshu Ikeda Bank, Ltd. - Non-Consolidated>

- **Core banking profit** amounted to **11.4 bn yen**, up 3.4 bn yen year on year (up 1.2 bn yen from the forecast).
- **Interest income** amounted to **28.1 bn yen**, up 4.9 bn yen year on year, primarily due to increases in interest on loans and interest on securities.
- **Core business profit** amounted to **6.5 bn yen**, up 1.5 bn yen year on year, primarily due to an increase in difference between loan and deposit interest rates following the BOJ's policy rate hike.
- Regarding **net credit costs**, for the FY2024 interim period, a partial reversal of the preventive reserve for possible loan losses, recorded in anticipation of the commencement of repayments on zero-zero financing loans, resulted in a gain on reversal. There were no such special factors in the FY2025 interim period, resulting in a **1.7 bn yen increase year on year to 1.2 bn yen** (up 0.2 bn yen from the forecast).

Progress on the Fifth Medium-Term Business Plan Plus

(The Fifth Medium-Term Business Plan (FY2021 to FY2023) has been rolled forward to FY2025.)

<Progress on the Fifth Medium-Term Business Plan Plus>

- The **number of cases of solution consulting**, a KPI for our thorough solution business, was **6,006 in the FY2025 interim period**, demonstrating a steady increase toward the **FY2025 full-year target of 12,000**.
- For the FY2025 interim period, the HD's **profit attributable to owners of the parent** reached **8.6 bn yen with ROE at 7.1%**, progressing steadily toward the full-year targets of **14.7 bn yen and 6.1%, respectively**.

<Efforts toward Enhanced Corporate Value>

- **[ROE Target]** In an effort to achieve a PBR of 1, we will aim at ROE of 8% in FY2028, assuming that the BOJ's policy rate will be 0.75%.
- **[Revision to Return Policies]** For FY2025, we had planned to pay out dividends per share of 16 yen or more. Together with flexible share buybacks, the shareholder return ratio would have been 40% or higher. For FY2026 and beyond, we had planned to progressively increase dividends as profit grows, aiming for a dividend payout ratio of 40%.
⇒ The target **dividend payout ratio was revised to 40%** in FY2025 (**one year ahead of schedule**) and the dividend per share was **revised** from 16 yen to **21 yen per share**.

<Digital Bank (Strategic Investment) 01Bank Launched in July 2025>

- **Number of registered accounts: 1,369; number of loans executed: 162; loan balance: 0.87 bn yen** (all as of October 31, 2025)
- Many businesses eligible for loans are in the **service and information & communications sectors**, with **applications coming from across the country**, primarily from the **Tokyo metropolitan area and Kansai region**.

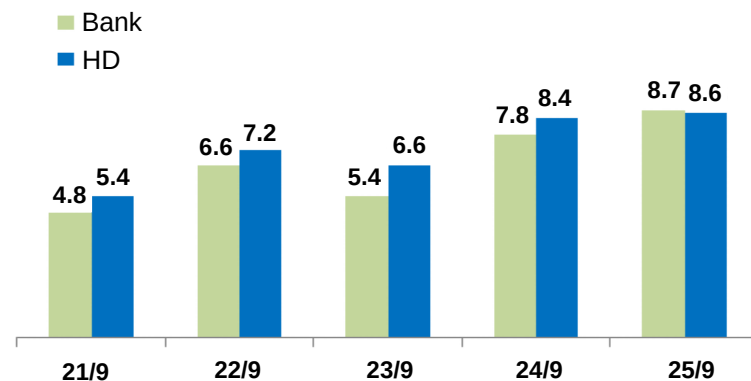

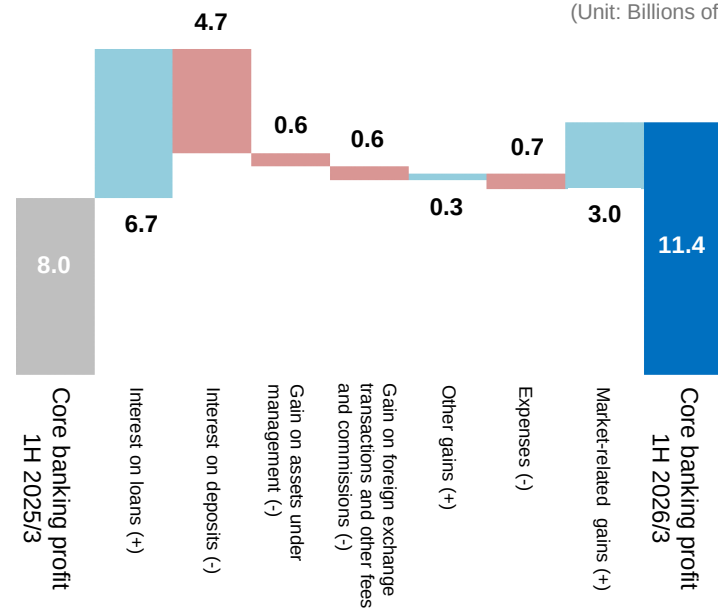
Trends in Net Income / Profit Attributable to Owners of the Parent

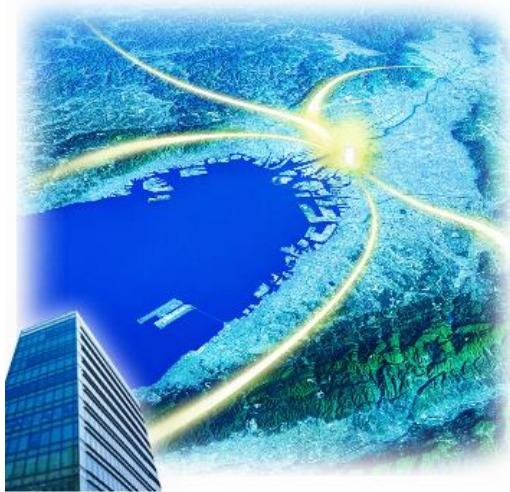
(Unit: Billions of yen)
