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Notice Regarding the Impact of the "2026 Kumamoto Earthquake" (Update on Previous Disclosure)

In relation to the impact of the "2026 Kumamoto Earthquake" which occurred on July 28, 2026, the Company released a "Notice Regarding the Impact of the '2026 Kumamoto Earthquake'" on July 31. The Company hereby announces the following projected schedule for the resumption of operations on certain railway sections where service is currently suspended.

1. Projected Schedule for Service Resumption

(1) Kyushu Shinkansen (between Kumamoto and Shin-Minamata)

Operations are projected to resume on September 18, 2026.

*Note: This anticipated schedule remains subject to revision contingent upon future conditions, including aftershocks.

*Note: Even after the resumption of operations, trains will continue to operate at reduced speeds on certain railway sections. Consequently, some train services between Kumamoto and Kagoshima-Chuo will be canceled or subject to schedule changes (while operations between Hakata and Kumamoto will be maintained at the pre-earthquake frequency and schedule).

(2) Kagoshima Main Line (between Uto and Yatsushiro)

Operations are targeted to resume around mid-October 2026.

*Note: This anticipated schedule remains subject to revision contingent upon future conditions, including aftershocks.

2. Amount of Damage and Impact on Business Performance

The extent of damages caused by this earthquake and its impact on the Company's business performance are currently under investigation. Should any matters requiring timely disclosure arise in the future, the Company will promptly make an announcement.
