About the ESG Finance Awards Japan and “Environmental Sustainable Company”

Launched in 2019, these awards recognize and share the advanced initiatives of companies and financial institutions that have actively engaged in ESG finance or environmental/social projects and created a significant social impact. The “Environmental Sustainable Company” category selects companies that meet specific criteria for information disclosure regarding material environmental issues, including “Risks, Business Opportunities, and Strategies,” “KPIs,” and “Governance”.

Background of Selection and Daiseki’s Initiatives Guided by its long-term management vision, “VISION 2030,” Daiseki operates as an “environment-creating company” to promote initiatives aimed at achieving carbon neutrality and a circular economy. We believe the following activities and our commitment to information disclosure led to this recognition:

- **Promotion of Carbon Neutrality:** In addition to reducing our own emissions through the introduction of renewable energy, we contribute to reducing our customers' CO2 emissions by recycling industrial waste without incineration. In the fiscal year ended February 2025, our CO2 reduction contribution reached 643,000 t-CO2 (equivalent to the annual emissions of approximately 250,000 average households).
- **High-Transparency Information Disclosure:** In the “Integrated Report 2026,” we provide detailed explanations of our management philosophy and business model. Furthermore, we strive for proactive disclosure, as evidenced by being named to the CDP Climate Change “A List”—the highest rating awarded by the international environmental non-profit—for three consecutive years.

As an “environment-creating company” Daiseki will continue to strive for further growth while contributing to the sustainable development of the environment, society, and the economy.
